

Bergs Tell of European Trip

Salemites Attend International Food Meet In Rome

Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Berg, who recently returned from a European trip, told Chamber of Commerce members their impressions Monday, dividing the time and speaking in separate themes.

They went abroad for the third international food congress in Rome, which 130 American representatives attended, and visited six countries, going as far north as Holland.

Berg, a food retailer as well as Chamber president, was pleased to find that the strawberries in a beautiful American food exhibit at the congress came from Lebanon, Oregon. He noted the anxiety people live under in some European countries without popular rule, and the superiority of American living and business standards. He indicated that he liked Holland best of the lands visited, and commented on the friendliness of the people there.

Mrs. Berg talked principally on the food, which she described as rather uniformly excellent in the different countries. Spain appeared to be her favorite country. They saw considerable of it, as she has relatives there. 11 p.m. is a popular time for the evening meal, she said. They dined in one Copenhagen restaurant that served 176 different kinds of sandwiches, at which Elmer ordered only one, chicken, she said.

Claude Miller, vice president, who presided, introduced William Hamilton, first president of the Chamber when its name was changed from Commercial club. Miss Florence Beardsley, president of the Salem B.P.W., spoke briefly. Its members attended in a body. Invocation was by the Rev. Lowell Holte of Grace Lutheran church.

Judge Fined \$5 for Lack Of License

PORTLAND (AP) — Municipal Judge Philip M. Bagley was fined \$5 Monday for driving a car after his operator's license had expired. Dist. Judge Ray D. Shoemaker, assessing the fine, observed that "anybody can forget the due date on his license." Each driver's license expires on his birthday.

Bagley, who said his arrest by a sheriff's deputy was part of a program of harassment of city officials, was not in court. His attorney entered a guilty plea for him, but offered a receipt, too, showing the license now has been renewed.

Shoemaker said \$5 is the same fine he recently gave another motorist on the same charge. Another charge against Bagley, failure to transfer title to his automobile, was dropped when it was learned the transfer had been made.

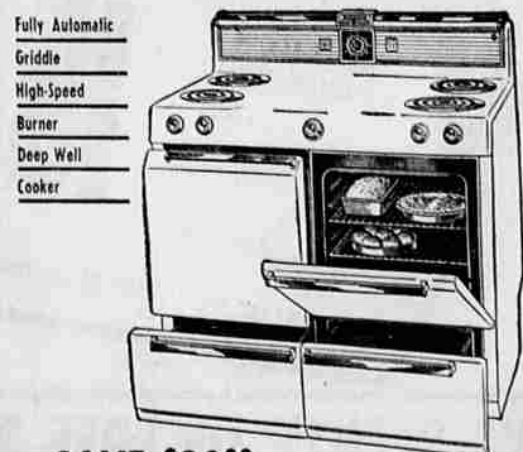
