

### Lutherans OK Setting Up of Own Schools

HARRISBURG, Pa. (AP)—America's largest Lutheran church today was pledged to help establish parochial schools — wherever it believes public schools are falling down on the job.

Delegates to the United Lutheran Convention gave resounding approval to the broad-scale program last night, after a scrappy two-hour floor debate over the merits of public versus church education.

The "total educational experience of the child should be a Christian one," declared the Rev. Herbert N. Gihney of Hempstead, N.Y. Public schools, he said, can't provide that approach.

Dr. Armin G. Weng, president of the Chicago Lutheran Seminary, shot back that it's erroneous to hold that mathematics, reading, chemistry or physics can be taught in any "particular Christian context."

That's a "false basis to a false thesis," he said. He added that judging from the church's record in Sunday schools and other educational efforts, he doubted it could do as well as public schools.

In the windup, the convention took a middle-road course, recognizing public schools as "a basic institution for general education," but favoring church schools in special circumstances.

### First A-Bomb Drop Made by British Plane

ADELAIDE, Australia (AP)—Britain test-dropped an "operational" atomic weapon from a plane for the first time today. She pronounced the test a success.

The bomb was dropped from a four-jet Valiant bomber flying about three miles high over the Maralinga test range in southern Australia. It was the third in Britain's current series of four test blasts, but the first to be described as an actual weapon ready for use in event of war.

The air drop was generally considered a dress rehearsal for Britain's first hydrogen bomb test on Christmas Island next spring. Air force officials who will take part in that operation watched today's blast.

A huge fireball dimmed the afternoon sun as the bomb went off. A smoke cloud spread in all directions in patterns somewhat different from the usual mushroom formation which follows ground bursts.

A report from the blast scene said scientists already were moving into the area to check conditions. A fleet of Royal Air Force Canberra bombers was tracing the atomic cloud.

### Miss Sullivan Not Ill, Didn't Like Her Role

NEW YORK (AP)—Actress Margaret Sullivan says the reason she failed to appear in a television play Monday night was because she was not satisfied with her rehearsal performance.

The 45-year-old stage and screen star said last night she told the show's producer Felix Jackson she could not go through with the show.

"I insisted I be replaced," Miss Sullivan said, adding, "The producer apparently did not take me seriously."

Miss Sullivan stayed away from CBS' Studio One performance of "The Pilot," a play based on the life of a nun, Sister Mary Aquinas. The performance was called off and a kinescope (film) of a previous program was shown.

Kenneth A. Wagz, Miss Sullivan's husband, earlier told newsmen his wife was ill and in a hospital, but would give no further details.

In her statement, issued through her press agent and confirmed by her attorney, Miss Sullivan said "a misunderstanding took place" and she and her husband had been staying with friends, whom she did not identify.

The actress attributed her husband's explanation that she was ill to the fact that he is "a businessman not acquainted with show business."

### Parcels Don't Need Marking On Inspection

WASHINGTON (AP)—Postmaster General Summerfield announced today that the familiar label "may be opened for postal inspection" no longer is needed on sealed second, third and fourth class matter.

Summerfield said he had adopted the suggestion of his legal department that the inspection regulation is now so well known to the public that when the sender seals such packages he gives implicit authorization for its inspection.

The requirement for labeling has been in effect since 1921.

Summerfield said that when a mailer does not wish to have his mail opened for inspection, he needs only to mark the item "first class" and attach the proper first-class postage.
