

Estes Says Ike Doing Nothing To Curb Prices

Assails 'Hero-Worship' Of Big Business by Republicans

 INDIANOLA, Iowa (AP)—Sen. Estes Kefauver said today that big corporations are making many unjustified price increases and that President Eisenhower is doing "practically nothing" to "protect the consumer from this price-raising."
 "How could it be otherwise," he asked in a prepared speech, "when the Republican administration and apparently President Eisenhower himself regard the corporate managers who are instituting these price advances as some sort of gifted specie of supermen who can do no wrong?"
 "If there is one consistent thread through the last four years of Republican rule, it has been this hero-worship of men of big business."

"They are the golfing companions of the President and the men who come to dinner at the White House. And, of course, they arrange for the great bulk of the contributions to the Republican party."

The Democratic vice presidential candidate brought his campaign out to Midwest farming country today after three days of Eastern barnstorming.

He spent the night at Buffalo, N.Y. His schedule called for an early morning departure by plane for Des Moines, and then a 200-mile motorcade through small towns in central Iowa. In all, he had a 19-hour day in prospect.

At Buffalo last night, the Tennesseean launched his strongest attack of the campaign on his vice-presidential adversary, declaring that if Richard Nixon should ever become president, "the Republican Old Guard will be the master of America."

Eisenhower in a second term "would be a lame-duck president, forbidden by the Constitution ever to run again" so that Nixon "would be the man of the future in the Republican party," the senator said.

UF Spends Noon Raising Added Monies

The usual noon-day meeting of United Fund workers was not held Thursday noon but instead the time was spent in soliciting funds.

William H. Hammond, UF chairman, said that a number of unit managers had requested calling off the meeting in order that their workers could make more calls on prospective givers.

Pledges turned in Wednesday brought the UF total to \$164,562 or 72 per cent of the \$227,800 goal. Hammond said that everything possible was being done to reach the goal on Friday. If the returns at that time fall short, the campaign methods used will be evaluated and a new approach will be used.

Two important divisions which Hammond said would probably reach their goal Friday are the mercantile with 70 per cent pledged and the professional division with 80 per cent reported.

Hammond requested all individuals who have not yet been contacted by UF solicitors to call campaign headquarters at 3-6924.
