Nixon Carries His Campaign Back to East

Closes Fast California Tour by Parading in S. F. Chinatown

SAN FRANCISCO (# — Vice President Nixon takes his cam-paign for re-election eastward to-day after calling on his fellow Californians to choose President Elsenhower as "far the best qual-ified" leader to promote world peace.

Nixon, winding up an intensive one-day tour of his home state, told the San Francisco Press Club last night his travels across the nation have convinced him of two things:

Nixon leaves today for Elko, Nev., Boulder and Denver, Colo. He will continue his tour across the Midwest and into the industrial East.

He completed a grueling vote-seeking expedition in his native California amid the clang and glitter of a Chinatown "Double Tenth" parade, celebrating the 45th anniversary of the founding of the Chinese Republic.

The vice president and Mrs. Nixon rode perched high in a convertible just ahead of a 250-foot, red-headed dragon propelled by dozens of Chinese-Americans.

Nixon drew applause when he promised the United States under the Eisenhower administration would never write off people under Communist rule.

Rep. John Shelley (D-Calif) rebuked some in the crowd for booing when Nixon appeared and also when a telegram of greeting from Democratic presidential candidate Adlai Stevenson was read.

Nixon told newsmen he was highly pleased with what he had seen and been cold of Republican chances in California, declaring, "I think we will win."

He said that in the country generally "the Republican campaign seems to have gotten off the ground in the past 10 days or two weeks."
