New York Pier Work Delayed By Slowdowns

NEW YORK — A wave of slowdowns by longshoremen is disrupting work on many New York piers — five days after a federal court injunction ended an Atlantic and Gulf Coast waterfront strike.

The slowdowns, which developed yesterday, cut pier activity to 50 or 60 per cent of normal in certain areas. Many of the men reportedly took four times the usual time to perform routine tasks.

"I am sitting on top of a volcano. Tomorrow could be my Pearl Harbor. I have to watch it all the time," Brown said. He expressed the belief that the presence of the 6th Fleet in the tense Mediterranean is a strong deterrent force for peace.

"If I had to, I could set up a perimeter and send in armed (land) convoys to evacuate American civilians," he said. Protection of American civilians in the Mediterranean area is a 6th Fleet responsibility—Fleet personnel from the Gaza Strip in Palestine.

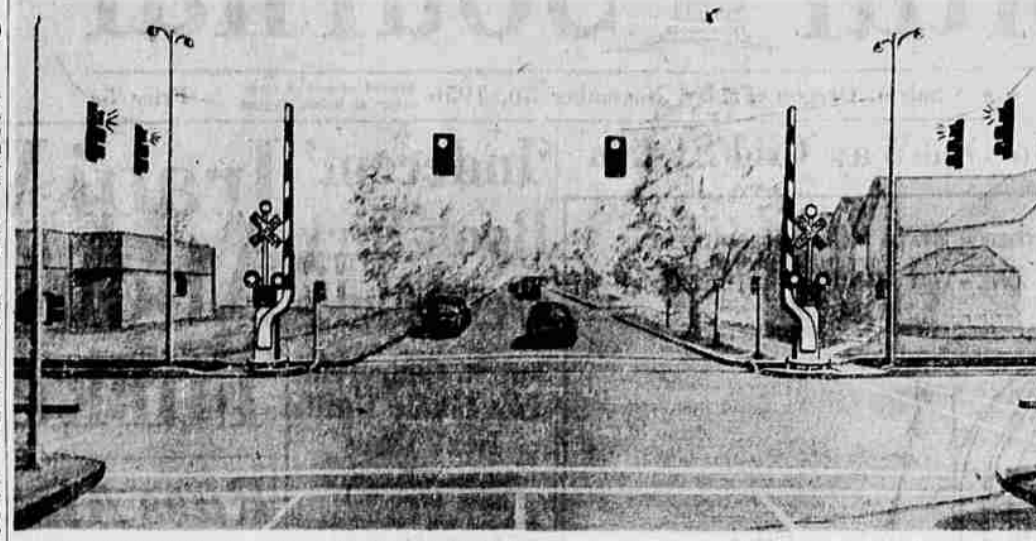
Navy Braved Mine Danger

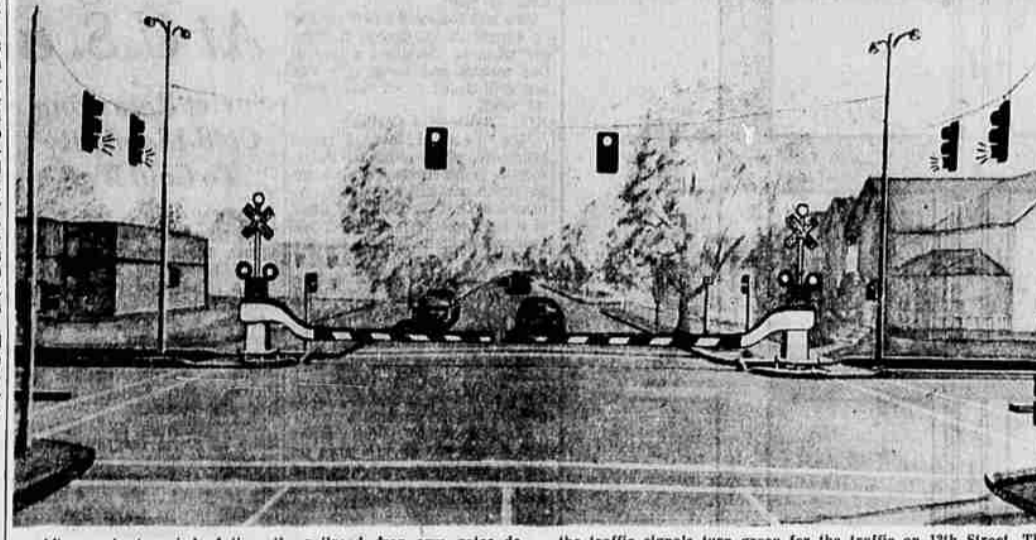
Portland Cattle Run 2nd Highest
