The council decided to make arrangements to complete the necessary connections in order that the new city well may be put into service.

Chief of Police Merle Grace reported on the bicycle safety program given to the grade school children.

The Chief of Police also reported that four boys, from the ages of 11 to 14, were caught shoplifting, and after making the boys return the merchandise, he took them to their homes and turned them over to their parents.

Street Commissioner Meissner reported on the installation of tile on Oak and Marquam streets; numbering of houses; cleaning up of flower beds, parks, and drainage ditches; also additional gravel placed on Leo and May streets.

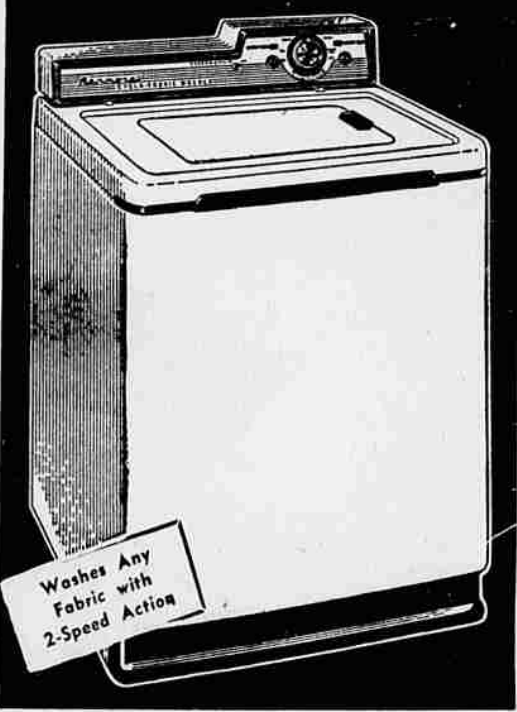

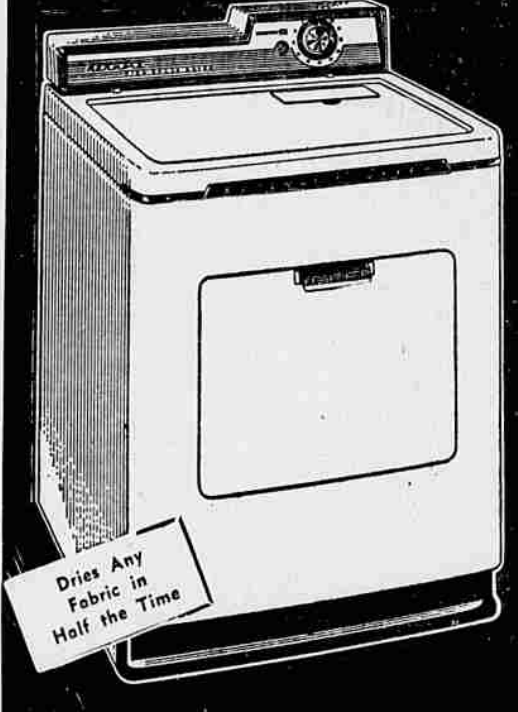
