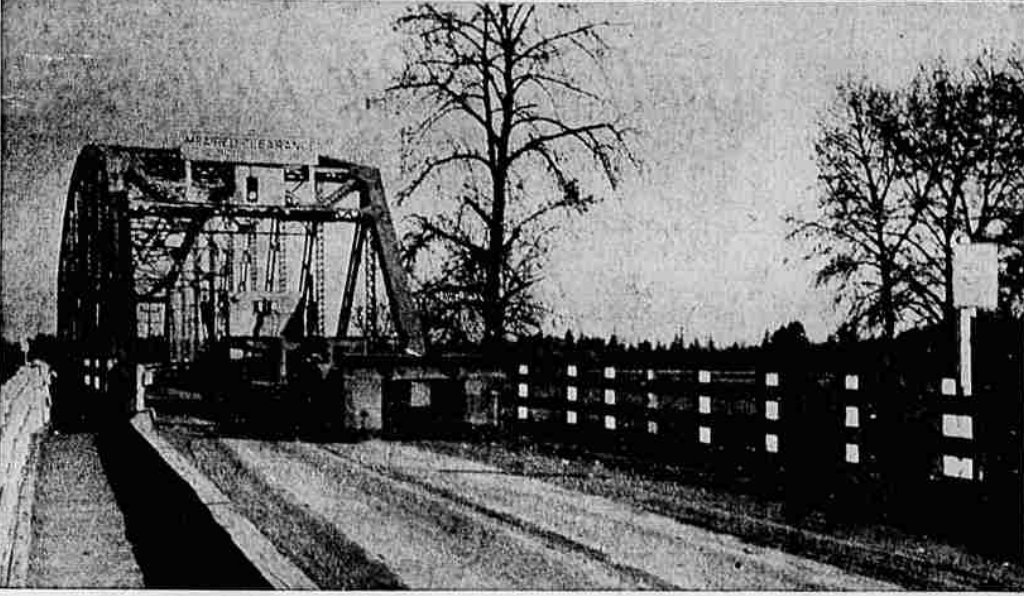
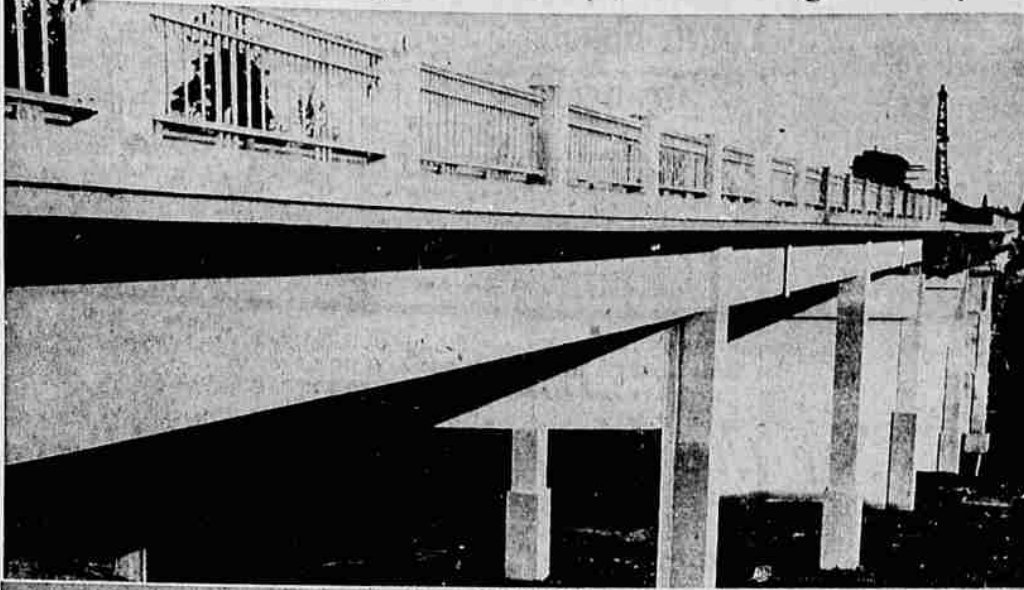


### New Welded Girder Replaces Old Yamhill Bridge at Dayton



### Victoria Snow Stalls Traffic

VICTORIA, B.C. (AP)—Taxi companies were booked solid three hours ahead Tuesday night and bus patrons were advised to start

for work an hour earlier than usual Wednesday following a paralyzing snowstorm here. Winds gusting up to 50 miles an hour swept heavy snow into 2 and 3 foot drifts in this Pacific Coast city which prides itself on its moderate winters. Large areas of the city and suburbs were left without power for periods up to two hours. Visibility was cut to a quarter
