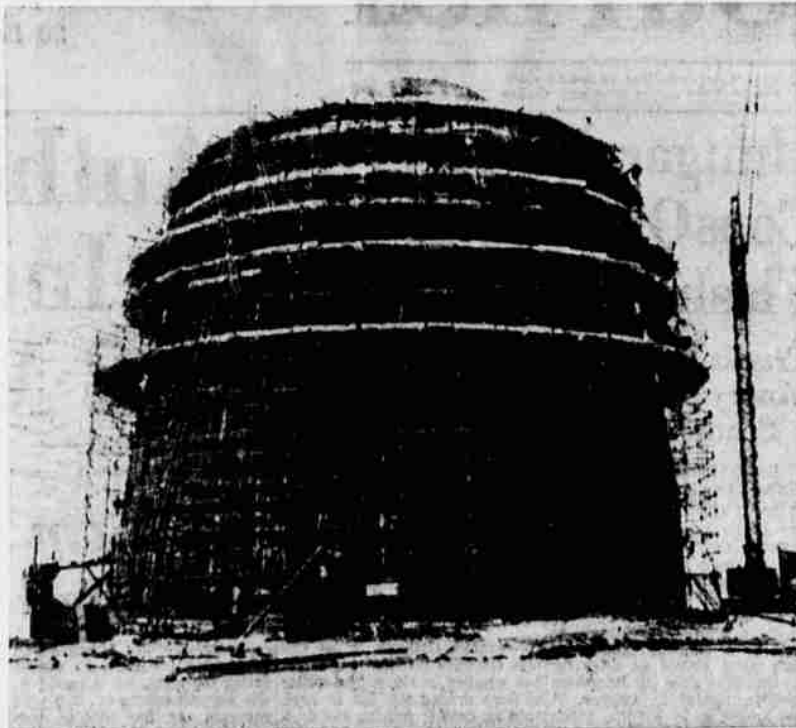


### Senators Seek To Delay Fight On Filibusters

WASHINGTON (AP)—Senators seeking to change Senate rules and make it easier to curb filibusters maneuvered Wednesday to delay the battle rather than having it in the opening hours of the new Congress Thursday. In a strategy session, the bipartisan coalition of Northern and Western senators including Sen. Nuberger (D-Ore.), created a steering committee to meet with Vice President Nixon and Senate party leaders to talk over the situation.

### GOP Chairman Hall Reported About to Quit

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Leonard W. Hall will step down as Republican national chairman some time after President Eisenhower's second term inauguration Jan. 21, administration sources said today. No date for Hall's resignation has been set, these sources said. A GOP committee spokesman formally denied published reports Hall will quit Jan. 19, the day the committee is slated to hold its next meeting here.

### Tacoman's Heart Stops for 21 Minutes; He's Well in 5 Days

SEATTLE (AP)—Thomas Van Wageningen's heart stopped for 21 minutes in a rare surgery case five days ago. A day later the 21-year-old Tacoman wanted to get out of bed. Doctors were amazed Wednesday at the speed of his recovery. The case was described as the second on the Pacific Coast in which the heart was stopped completely during the delicate corrective surgery inside the heart while a heart-lung machine took over its functions and kept the patient's blood circulating.

### Skiers Killed By Avalanche

NICE, France (UP)—Three members of a party of 17 skiers were killed by an avalanche that trapped them on isolated Mount Meichens, police reported today. Police said rescuers reported the other 14 were alive but "several" were injured.

### Ike Appoints 3 Cabinet Aides

WASHINGTON (UP)—President Eisenhower Tuesday appointed three new assistant secretaries of interior and health, education and welfare. The President appointed Ross L. Lefler, Philadelphia, to the newly created post of assistant secretary of interior for fish and wildlife.

WASHINGTON (AP)—Rep. Walter Norblad (R-Ore.) said Wednesday he will introduce in Congress on his opening day Thursday a bill to authorize the Yaquina Bay project.
