

Manslaughter Charges Filed In Auto Deaths

Faulty Brakes Blamed For 7 Drownings in Florida Accident

MIAMI, Fla. (AP)—Seven counts of manslaughter were charged yesterday against Ralph Evans, whose wife and five sons drowned with another lad in the plunge of Evans' car into a stream Saturday night.

"It was an unavoidable accident," Evans said in a Dade County Jail cell. "You can't get manslaughter out of it."

Bail was set at \$5,000 for arraignment before Peace Justice Hugh Duval, who issued manslaughter warrants to Constable W. M. Hudson.

The constable said mechanical condition of Evans' 11-year-old car was the basis of the charges.

Evans was quoted by police as first saying his brakes failed in an attempt to straighten out after a turn. At the jail, he told news-men he believed the brakes held and blamed the accident on refusal of the car to straighten out on loose gravel.

Evans, 50-year-old Hialeah Gardens junk dealer, and Edwin McDonough, 58, an acquaintance, were only survivors of a party of nine the car carried into eight feet of water near Evans' home. The two men struggled through an open window on the driver's side and tried in vain to extricate Mrs. Teresa Evans, 22, and the six children trapped in the overturned car.

Dead in the tragedy besides Mrs. Evans were Charles Wright Jr., 12, and five Evans children, George, 5, Henry, 4, Raymond, 2, and Louis and Anthony, 6-month-old twins.

Time Bombs in Stadiums Kill 11 in Algiers

ALGIERS (AP)—Time bombs left ticking in two crowded football stadiums took this capital's heaviest one-day toll of lives in the 27-month Algerian rebellion.

The bombings apparently were timed to mark the opening of the climactic week of U. N. Assembly debate on the Algerian rebellion.

The bombs exploded yesterday during soccer games in the Hussein Municipal Stadium and El Biar Stadium across town. Eleven persons were killed and at least 45 wounded.

In the countryside, French troops announced they had killed 66 nationalist rebels in scattered clashes during the last 24 hours. Another bomb exploded in a crowded Algiers cafe Saturday night, killing 3 and injuring 10.

The renewed terrorism in the capital followed two of the calmest weeks since the rebellion spread here from eastern Algeria 11 months ago. Firm action by French authorities kept an eight-day nationwide strike of Moslem Merchants and workers, timed to coincide with the U. N. debate, from full success.

Hotplate Sets Hotel on Fire

PORTLAND (AP)—Fire in an old hotel for transients here early Sunday drove scores of men into the street in their nightclothes and resulted in serious burns to a janitor.

He is M. Hiraou, 76, in whose trash-filled room the fire started from an overheated hotplate.

H. Pat Lee, 51, who lived in the next room, was overcome by smoke.

The fire, in the second story of the U.S. Hotel on S.W. Front Ave., was seen by a passing motorist who called the fire department at about 2 a.m.

The blaze was confined to Hiraou's room.

Autoist Held For Homicide

PAYETTE, Idaho (AP)—Raleigh Williams, 22, Spokane, must face trial for negligent homicide in the traffic deaths of a mother and her three children.

Probate Judge W. S. Stephenson ordered Williams bound over Saturday. Date of the trial was not set.

Williams is charged as the driver of a car which collided with a car driven by William Holmes, 32, Chesire, Ore., last July 15 near Fruitland, Idaho. Killed in the crash were Holmes' wife, Marjorie, and three of their children—Lorray, 8, Larry, 5, and Gloria, an infant.

Williams is free on \$1,000 bond. He has been living at Fruitland.

Syria Asks Expulsion Of Israel From UN

DAMASCUS (AP)—Syrian Prime Minister Sabri Assal has called for the expulsion of Israel from the United Nations.

He said in a statement issued by the government information office that would be "the least adequate penalty for Israel's continuous defiance of U.N. resolutions calling for the immediate withdrawal of her forces from Gaza and Sharm el Sheikh."
