Anne Bancroft, freshly divorced, thinks she knows one reason why so many Hollywood marriages fail: Career women marry and they shouldn't.

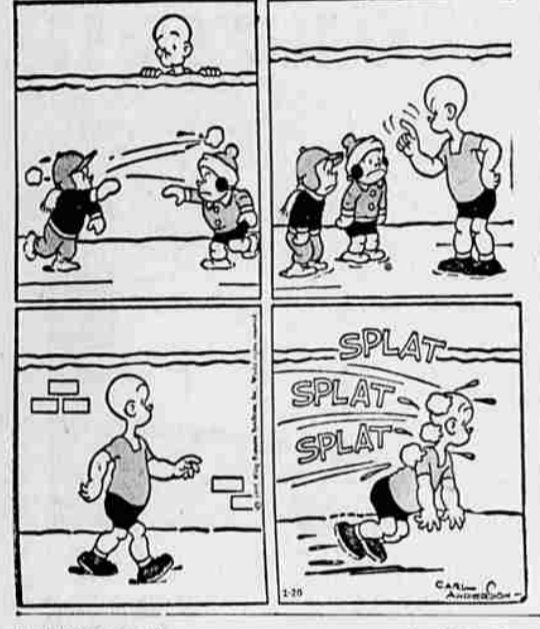

LONDON (AP)—The British government's Cyprus policy has been endorsed by the House of Commons. Prime Minister Harold Macmillan's Labor party parliamentary maneuver expressing dissatisfaction last night 307-253 while British diplomats also were defending the policy in the U.N.

Suicide Rate Low in Ore.

PORTLAND (AP)—The state Board of Health reported Tuesday that Oregon's suicide rate dropped 24 per cent last year to a probable record low. Its report shows 196 suicides for a rate of 11.3 per 100,000 residents last year. The former low rate was 12.1 in 1917. The rate in 1955 was 14.8 when there were 251 suicides.

Smash Kills 1 Hotrodder In Cemetery

NEW YORK (AP)—A stripped-down car, driven by two young hot rodgers, smashed into a row of tombstones in a Bronx cemetery yesterday. One boy was killed, the other critically injured. Police said the two youths apparently were testing their car on a road in St. Raymond's cemetery when it went out of control.

Building Falls Apart in Rio; Nobody Killed

RIO DE JANEIRO, Brazil (AP)—Firemen reported Wednesday there was not a single death in the collapse of an 11-story building which speared tons of rubble across one of the city's main shopping streets at the rush hour Tuesday.
