### Public-Private Atomic Power Inquiry Starts

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Joint Senate-House Atomic Energy Committee has started looking into the question of public vs. private construction of atomic power plants.

The inquiry ultimately may become a factor in determining future construction plans for construction of both government-financed and privately financed power plants.

But, thus far, there has been no specific mention of individual plants that might be affected by the inquiry.

Atomic Energy Commission members are themselves in disagreement on the best means of promoting peaceful development of atomic energy.

Chairman Lewis L. Strauss has told the committee that progress toward development of an independent atomic energy industry "has been most encouraging" over the past year.

Commission member Thomas E. Murray on the other hand said he didn't think progress was "adequate" because private industry can't take over the job.

### Portland Man Dies in Wreck

BRIDAL VEIL, Ore. (AP) — Clyde William Middleton, 63, of Portland was killed Wednesday night when he was thrown from his automobile near here.

Multnomah County sheriff's deputies said Middleton apparently fell asleep at the wheel and the car veered across the road, where it struck a cement marker post.

The impact flipped the car over and Middleton was thrown out onto the road and crushed by the vehicle as it rolled over several times on the highway.

Deputies said his body was found at the bottom of a bank along the highway, about 30 feet from where the car finally came to rest.

### Michigan Again Sniper-Plagued

PORT HURON, Mich. (UPI) — A new "phantom sniper" has appeared on the Michigan scene. Police said they thought they had the problem solved with the arrest of Gary Taylor, 20, a few weeks ago. Taylor, who fired his .22 caliber rifle only at girls and women, was arrested early this month after a two-month reign of terror in Detroit's suburbs and now is awaiting a sanity hearing.

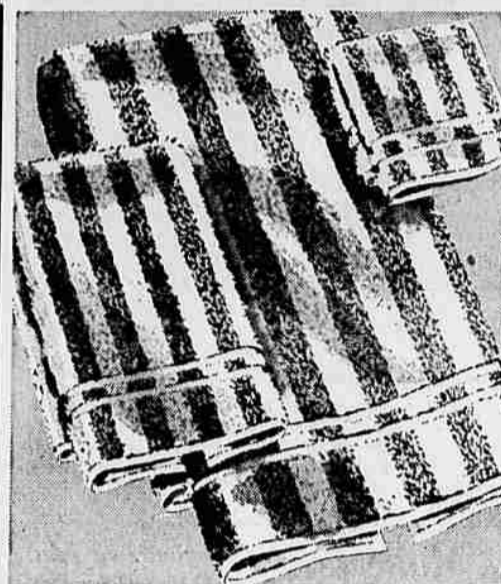
