

### Rains Assure Full Output of Power by BPA

PORTLAND (AP)—A full supply of power will be available from the Bonneville Power Administration through the spring and into the summer, the federal agency announced today.

Bonneville Administrator William A. Pearl said improved water conditions as a result of heavy rains in the Pacific Northwest in the past 10 days make certain that interruptible power commitments can be met.

The interruptible power supply of 500,000 kilowatts was restored completely last week, but without assurance that it could be continued. It is used by 17 Northwest electro-processing plants.

Interruptible power, available only after the needs of contract users are met, was cut off twice, once in November and again in January.

Bonneville officials said water supplies are good in all federal reservoirs, including Grand Coulee, Hungry Horse, Albeni Falls, and the Detroit and Lookout Point projects on the Willamette River.

Detroit and Lookout Point are releasing water to leave space for flood control. At Grand Coulee the level of the reservoir has increased by four feet in the past 10 days.

### Papers Claim Hughes Wed

NEW YORK (AP)—Millionaire Howard Hughes and actress Jean Peters were married secretly several days ago, newspapers reported yesterday.

Hughes, 51, oil man, industrialist, aviator and movie maker, first met Miss Peters, 30, about 10 years ago. They appeared together frequently but in 1954 Miss Peters married Texas oilman Stuart W. Cramer 3rd.

The couple separated after a few months and Miss Peters filed for divorce in 1955. The actress' last movie was "A Man Called Peter."

Hughes originally was married in 1925 to Ella Rice of Houston, Tex. The marriage ended in divorce four years later.

Neither Hughes nor Miss Peters was available for comment.

### Soehren Files \$10,000 Suit

A pedestrian-motor vehicle accident of last Aug. 3 on a Church street crosswalk resulted in a \$10,000 personal injury damage suit being filed in Marion County Circuit Court.

W. Lloyd Soehren, as the plaintiff, charges negligence on the part of Joseph Alton DeShazer, driver, and Fred W. Drueker, owner of the pickup truck involved.

The complaint states that Soehren was struck by the truck while it was making a turn from Center onto Church street.
