### Rains Assure Full Output of Power by BPA

PORTLAND OF - A full supply of power will be available from the Bonneville Power Administration through the spring and into the summer, the federal agency announced today.

Bonneyille Administrator Wil liam A. Pearl said improved wa-ter conditions as a result of heavy rains in the Pacific Northwest in the past 10 days make certain that interruptible power commitments

The interruptible power supply of 500,000 kilowatts was restored completely last week, but without assurance that it could be continied. It is used by 17 Northwes electro-processing plants.

Interruptible power, available only after the needs of contract users are met, was cut off twice, once in November and again in January.

Bonneville officials said water supplies are good in all federal reservoirs, including Grand Cou-lee, Hungry Horse, Albeni Falls, and the Detroit and Lookout Point

and the Detroit and Lookout Point projects on the Willamette River.

Detroit and Lookout Point are releasing water to leave space for flood control. At Grand Coulee the level of the reservoir has increased by four feet in the past 10 days.
