Method: Turn oyster stew (according to can directions) into a 1-quart saucepan. Allow to stand, stirring often, over low heat until completely defrosted. Laft out oysters with slotted spoon and reserve. Stir flour and water together until smooth; stir into hot soup. Cook and stir constantly until soup thickens and boils. Add reserved oysters, ham, celery and reserved oysters, ham, celery and pimiento; heat but do not boil. Serve with crisp buttered toast points. Makes 3 servings.
