Then, he said, the offer to help was made to the Sumter NAACP chapter "as offers are similarly made wherever help is needed and the church feels it has a duty to perform."

Brundage Says He Acts Merely

WASHINGTON (UP)—Percival
F. Brundage, the man in the middle today of the big budget row,
maintains he acts only as President Eisenhower's deputy in the
drawing up of the federal budget.
Moreover, Brundage, who as Eisenhower's budget director is under fire from congressional conservatives, has picked up support
for his position from Senate Republican Leader William F. Knowland.

The conservatives blame Brun dage for letting through what they call the "wasteful" spending proposals in the administration's record peacetime budget of almost

record peacetime budget of almost 72 billion dollars.

Sen. Harry F. Byrd, a leader of the Senate economy bloc, said Thursday he should be replaced by a man "dedicated to cutting the budget."

Republican critics of the administration of the saministration of the s

istration also have been using Brundage as a scapegoat to blame for internal party differences. Knowland indicated today he felt the President must assume re sponsibility for the scale of federal

spending.
"From my own contacts with
Brundage," he told a reporter, "I
think he is endeavoring to carry
out the President's policies and
that he is a man of integrity and
ability."
