Amnesia Story Hoax, Admits **AWOL Marine**

Seattle Railroader Arrested by FBI After Prints Check

SEATTLE (P - A railroad timekeeper who told Seattle police May 3 he could remem-

police May 3 he could remember nothing about himself prior to September, 1955 and asked who he was, was arrested yesterday by the FBI as a deserter from the Marine Corps.

Richard D. Auerbach, special agent in charge of the FBI office here, said a fingerprint check showed the man who called himself James John Kelly is really Joseph James Krankotz Jr., Butler, Pa.

Auerbach said Krankotz walked away from a Marine Corps training camp at Twentynine Palms, Calif., Sept. 20. 1955.

Krankotz admitted to the FBI his story of an amnesia attack was a hoax.

Krankotz's amnesia story first gained the spotlight last week when he and his wife asked for aid in identifying him. He said he was plagued by the uncertainty of not knowing whether he might have another wife somewhere.

Auerbach said Krankotz told officers Monday night that he never ficers Monday night that he never had been married before.

Krankota's carlier story had been that he remembered nothing of his identity after he awakened in a boxear in Scattle in 1955. He said the initials "J. J. K." on his wrist watch and a tattooed "J.K." on his arm led him to take the name of James John Kelly.

He said after his arrest that he had known he would be apprehended some time, with his fingerprints on file, but that he couldn't explain why he acted as he did.

Euratom Unit Urges Power Plants Speed

PARIS M — A three-man committee of the European Atomic Committee — Euraton — Wednesday urged speedy, large-scale development of nuclear power to protect West Europe against future interruptions in its oil supply.

Reporting after a six-month atudy, the three experts said the shortage of available power com-pared with Western Europe's needs "threatens to become a major brake on economic

major brake on economic growth."

The report pointed out that the recent Suez crisis had demonstrated the vulnerability of the supply of one of the most important energy sources, oil.

The three experts are Louis Armand of France, Franz Etzel of West Germany and Francesco Giordani of Italy. They reported to the governments which recently agreed to pool their atomic development programs under Eurvelopment programs under Eur-atom — France, West Germany, Italy, Belgium, Holland and Lux-

embourg.

The three experts estimated that by joining their efforts, the Euratom nations can develop nuclear power capacity of 15 million kilowatts a year in the next to years.
