\$500,000 Suit Filed by Earl Against Union

PORTLAND—Portland City Commissioner Stanley W. Earl, Monday filed a \$500,000 libel suit against members of the Oregon Joint Council of Teamsters, and the union's newspaper, the Oregon Teamster.

Earl, a former executive of the CIO in Oregon, asks \$250,000 general damages and \$250,000 punitive damages in the suit filed in circuit court.

The suit also states that after Earl, as commissioner, voted against licensing pinball machines in Portland, members of the Teamsters Joint Council repeatedly attempted to coerce and intimidate the plaintiff into changing his stand as to said machines.
