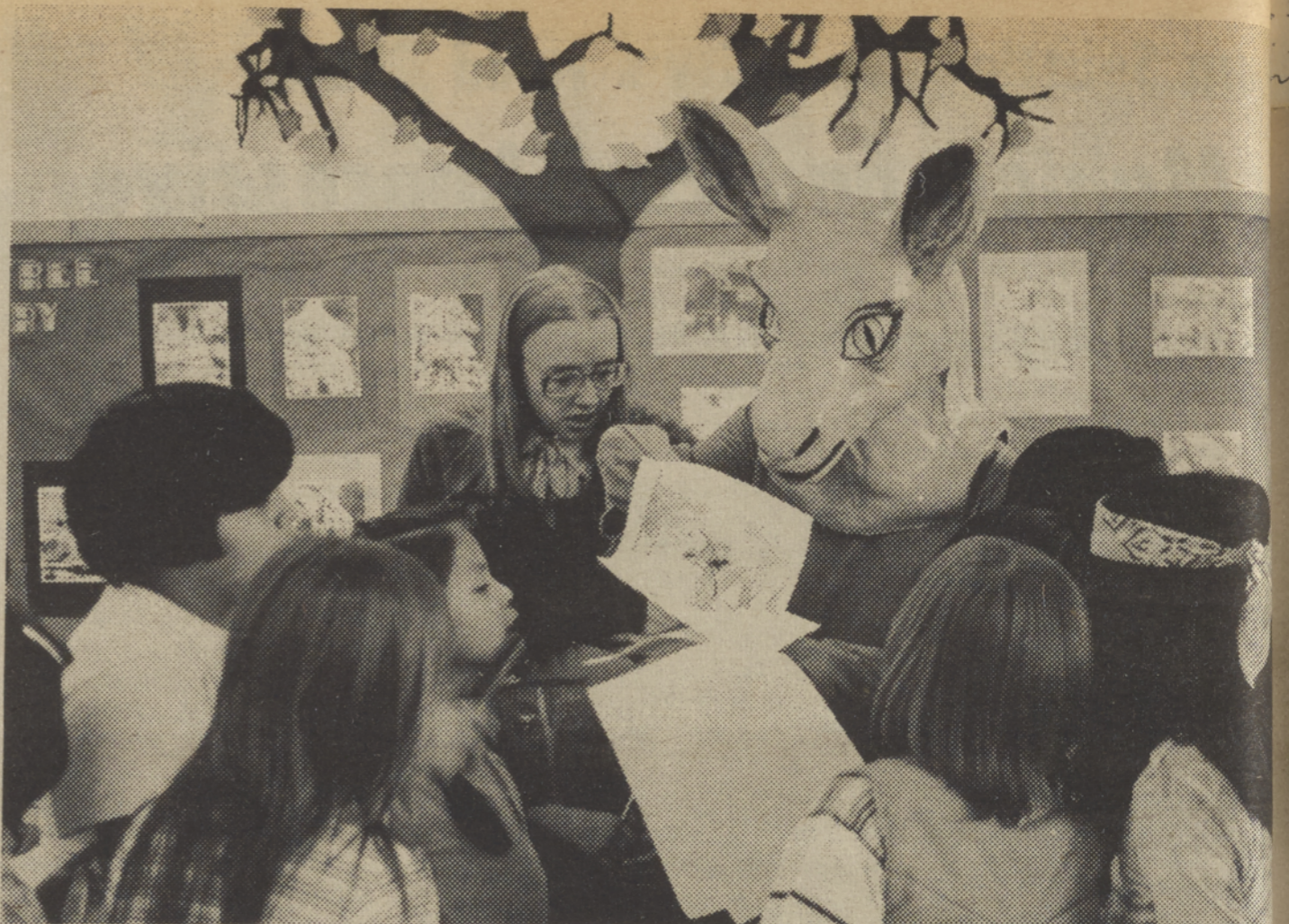

Cornett. But he feels that standards that are clear should be set and that the Bureau needs the type of management that would expect results. "The Bureau ought to be expected to produce - we should have the type of management that would expect the kind of dedication necessary to provide needed services," he added.

It would appear that the BIA Reorganization Task Force will receive a good deal of input from Warm Springs representa-

tives during their visit to Portland February 2. Since they will be in Portland for only one day, they have set some guidelines in order to accomplish in an orderly fashion what they set out to do.

Any group or individual presenting oral testimony must be on the agenda and must submit written backup material to members of the task force before speaking. Written statements will be accepted from those not wishing to make oral

statements.

At least four days prior to the meeting, those who wish to be heard should call Tribal Operations at the BIA area office. The telephone number is 234-3361, extension 4283.

According to Task Force Director Jack Rushing, minutes will be available about two weeks after the conference.

Other locations where field hearings will be conducted are Phoenix, Oklahoma City, Denver, and Deluth.
