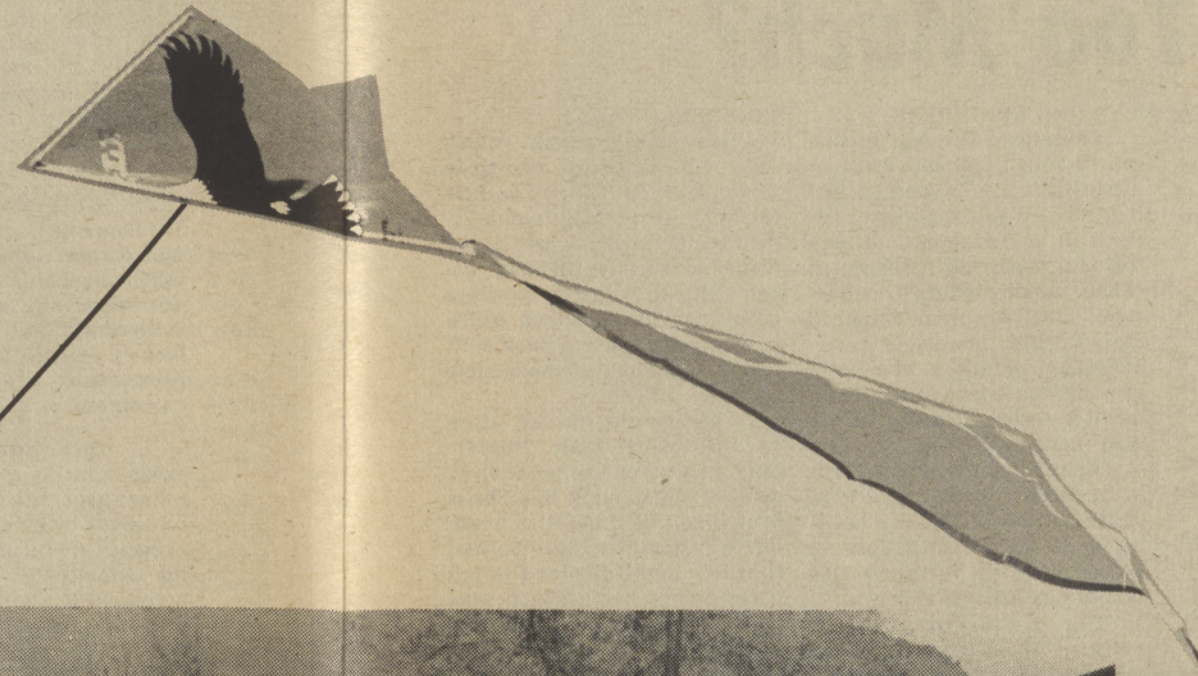
Fishin' Hole

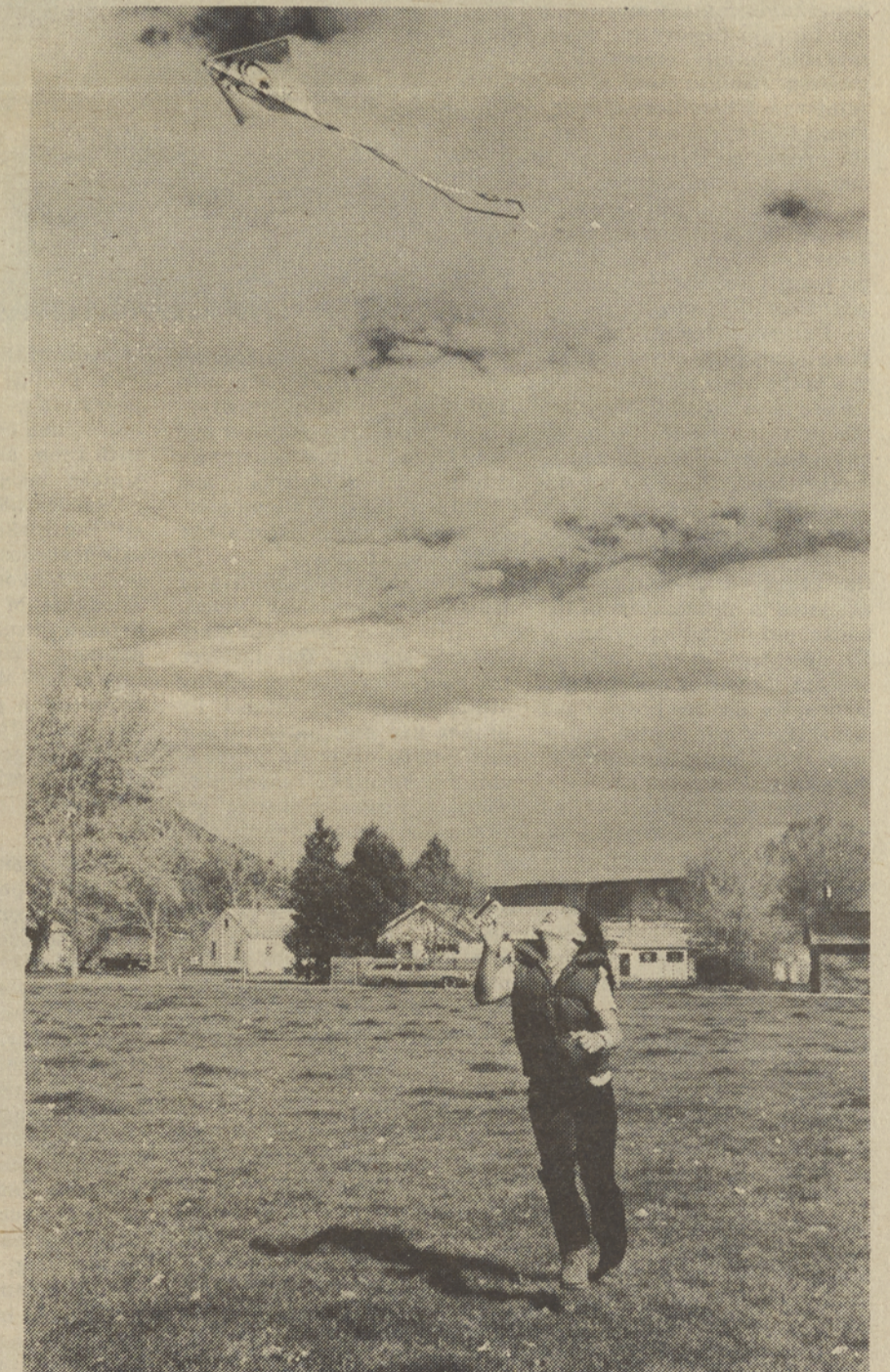
Good Egg
