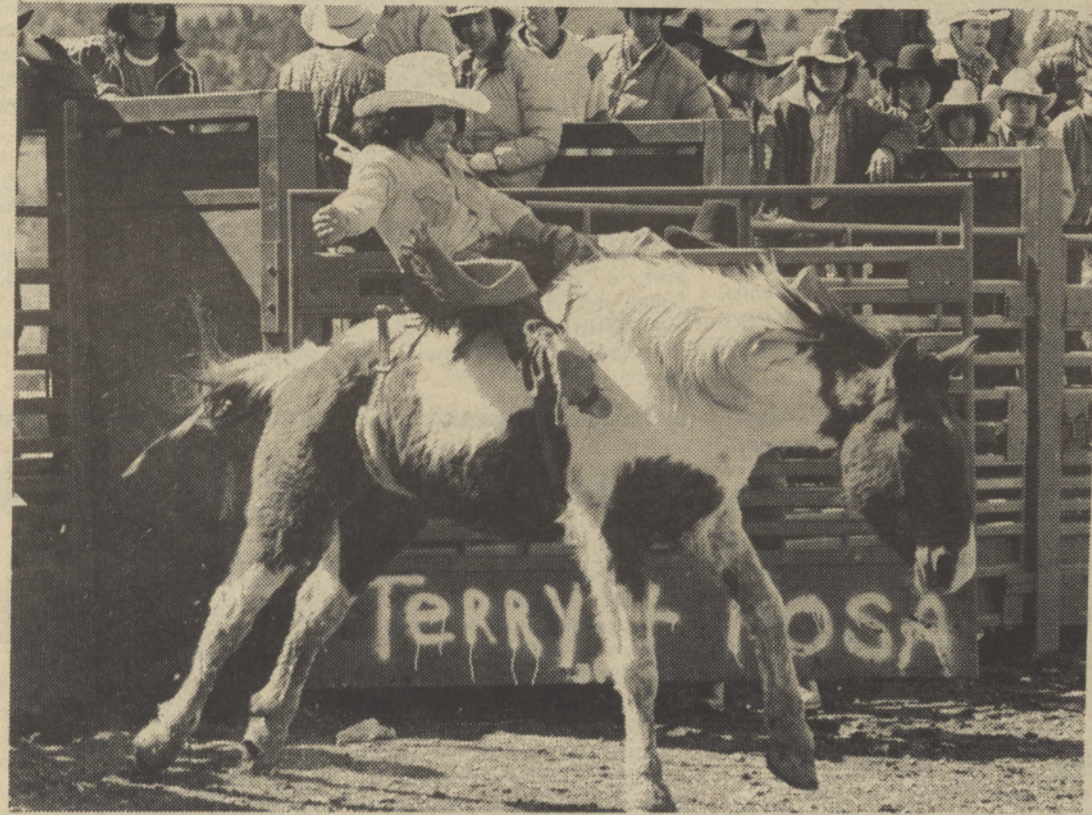
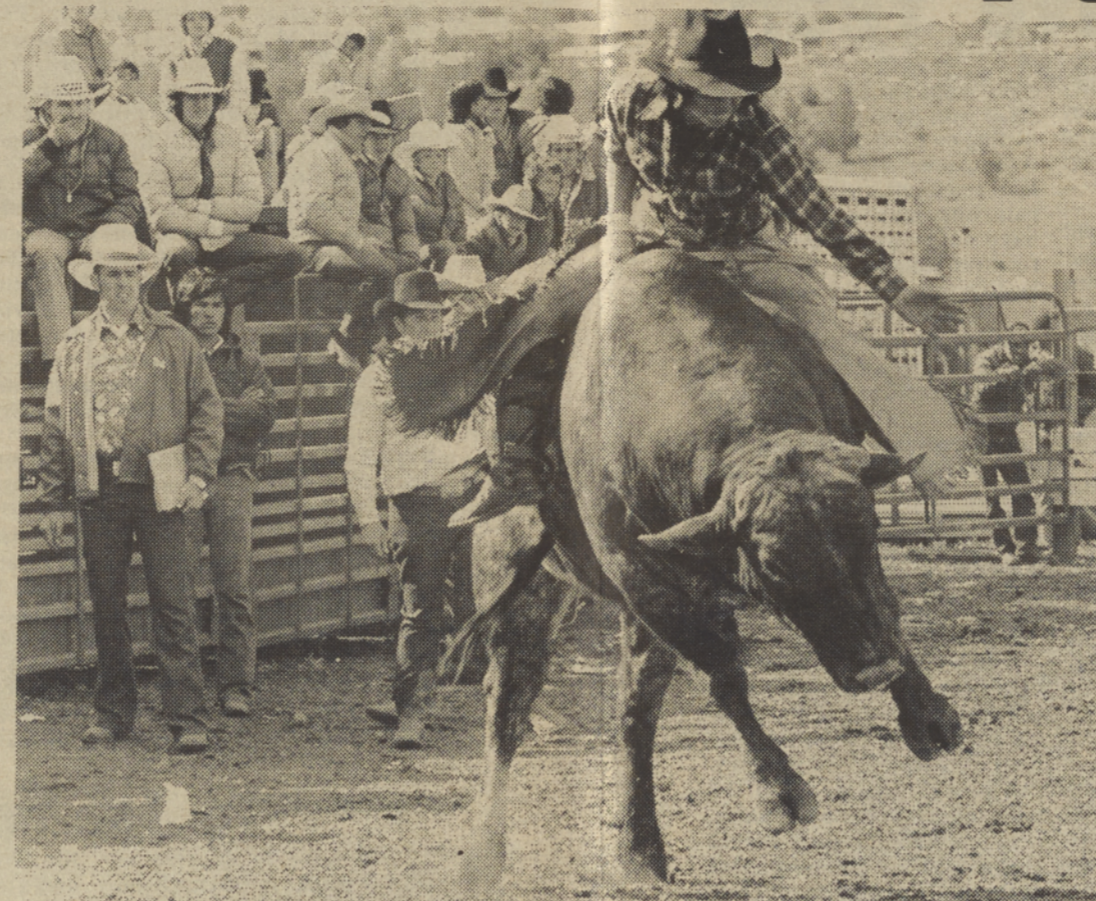


Record Crowd At Root Feast Rodeo

"Hobo" Patt warming up just like the other cowboy's do before the roping events.



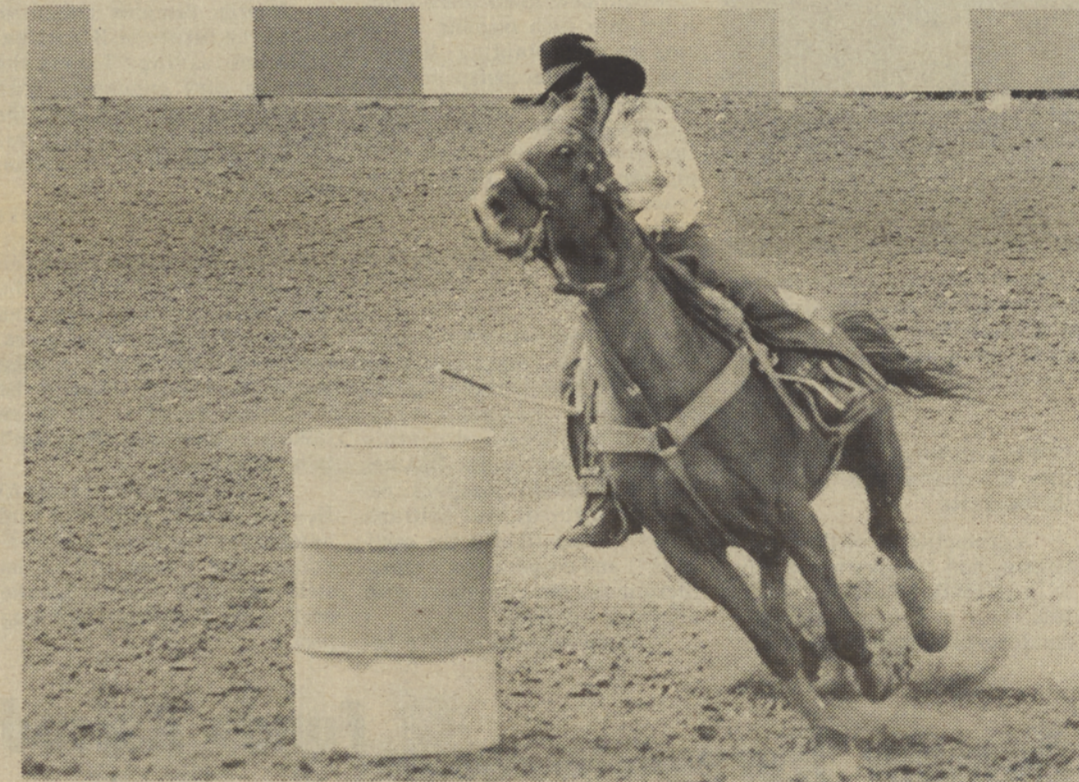
There were fast times in the calfroping as shown here LeRoy Scott is after this fast little calf.



Donnie Bagley making his first appearance in the cow riding, also winning the event, here he is set for the gate to open.



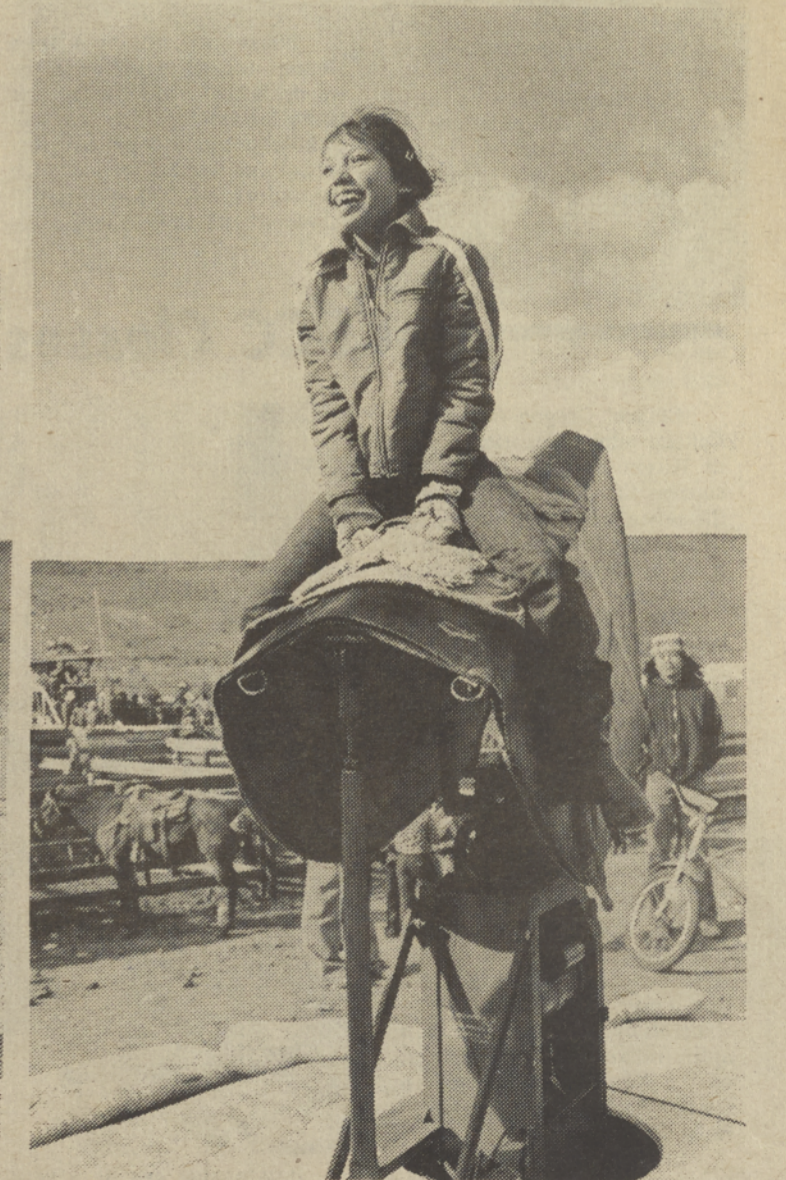
