help control the blaze. Airlifted into inaccessible areas, the two new crews tackled hot spots and did some burning out while helicopters made successive sweeps over the area, scooping buckets of water out of the nearby Warm Springs River.

Six spot fires flared outside the lines, one of them near Pauli's house, keeping weary firefighters on their toes. But by 4:00 p.m. Friday the fire was

controlled.

The Gifford Pinchot crews and helicopters were released Saturday morning and locals spent the next several days mopping up and improving access along the lines. As late as Tuesday, two pumper crews and a helicopter were putting out flare-ups under juniper trees near the lines. The area was patrolled through the week.
