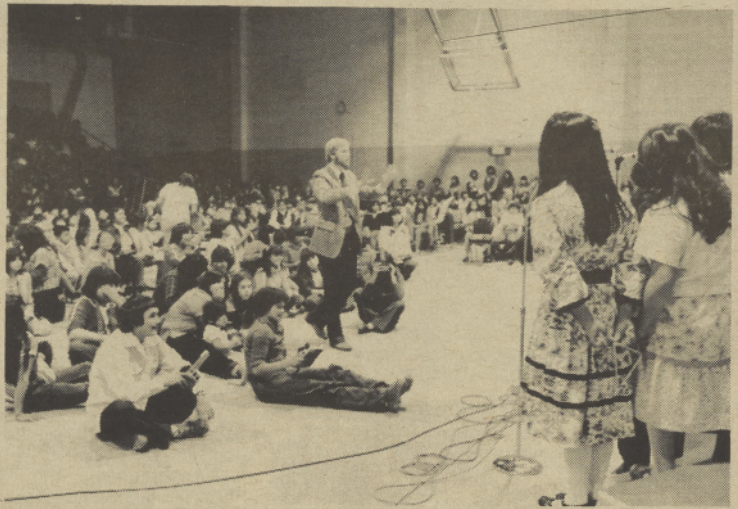


Christmas is . . .
