

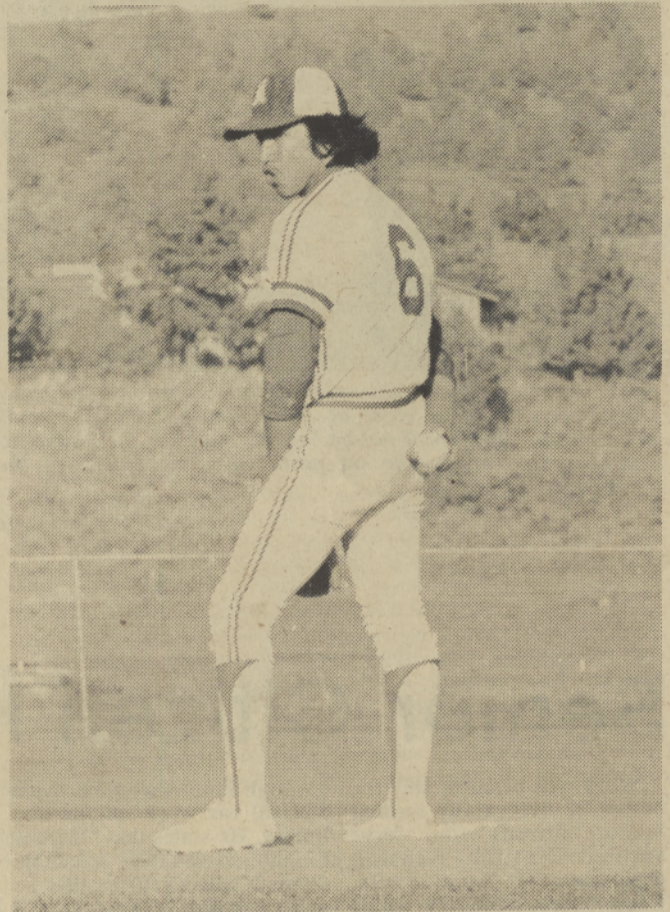

1. Only bikes up to 20" maximum rim diameter wheel are allowed.
 2. Handlebar Grips with unbroken ends or plugs, no end metal showing.
 3. The handlebar-crossbar, gooseneck (stem), frame top tube must be padded.
 4. All bolts & axles must be cut off to within 1/2" of the nut.
 5. No wing nuts or quick releases are allowed.
 6. No buddy pegs are allowed on bike
 7. No kickstands are allowed on bike
 8. No protruding metal or

- sharp objects are allowed.
 9. All nuts and bolts must be tight.
 10. The bike must be in a safe mechanical condition.
 11. Tires shall be in good condition with no apparent flaws.
 12. Brakes must be in proper adjustment, the brake must lock rear wheel.
 13. No fenders, chain guards or reflectors will be allowed.
 14. Riders must have helmets, mouth protectors, long sleeve shirts, long pants and lace up shoes.
