Thompson sentenced Jan. 8

Curtis Lee Thompson, 19, was sentenced January 18 in Madras Circuit Court to 180 days in jail and five years' probation for negligent homicide in the death of Larry S. Blasingame on July 26, 1981.

The charge, to which Thompson pleaded no contest on Dec. 7, 1981, stemmed from an incident in which the car driven by Thompson apparently went out of control, sailed over an embankment at the

Deschutes Trailer Court, and crashed into the trailer where Blasingame was sleeping.

Blasingame, 33, died of injuries a short time after he was transported to Mt. View Hospital in Madras.

The driver and several passengers abandoned the vehicle after the accident, but returned to the scene about an hour later, according to Jefferson County Sheriff's Department reports.

This is the first year the Lil' Miss Warm Springs contest has been held. Lil' Miss Warm Springs will reign for one year. Everyone is invited to attend.

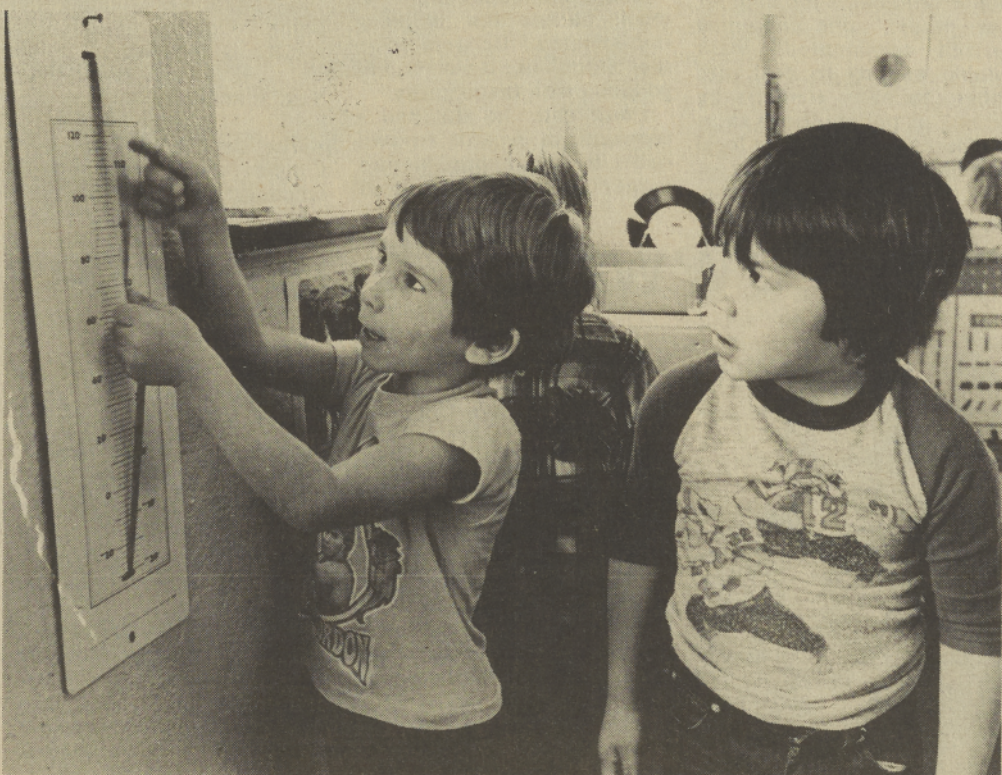
Class offered during noon
