The students receiving the citizenship awards for January

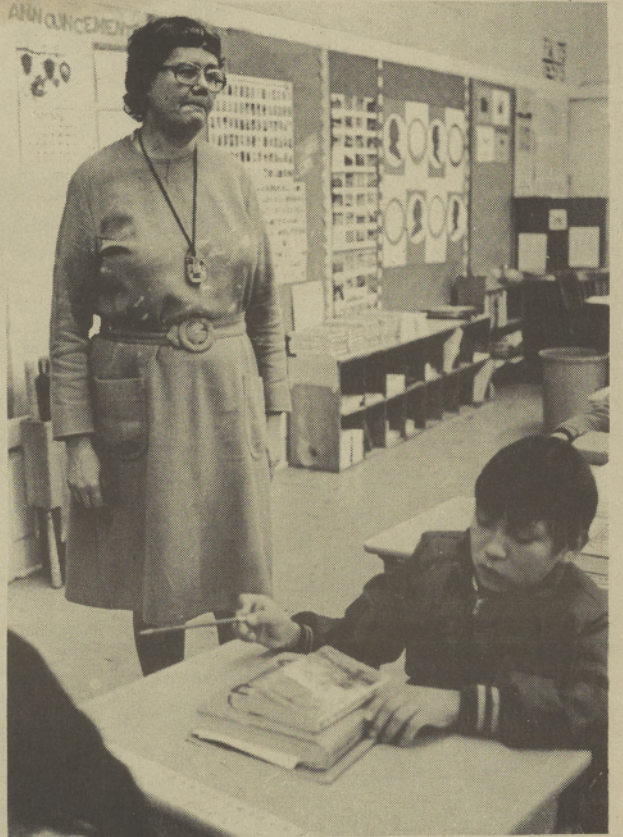

Tickets for the dinner will be available in the Jr. High school office beginning February 16. Adults and students will be charge \$3.00 The charge for

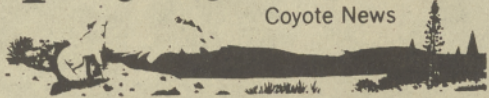
elementary age children and younger is \$1.50.
