Wilderness camp offered by COCC

This June, Central Oregon Community College will host its first Wilderness Adventure Summer Camp for students who are between the eighth grade and their senior year in high school.

Campers will be housed in the College dorms and will receive complete instruction in a variety of outdoor skills, says

camp director Doug Muck.

Rafting, canoeing, kayaking, backpacking, cave exploring, orienteering and biking are planned.

In-district students will have the first chance to sign up for the one-week sessions which will be offered at reduced rates until May 1. Warm Springs is in-district. A day camp session,

costing \$97.50 per week or \$19.50 per day, is set for June 13-17 followed by an overnight session June 20 to 24, which costs \$42.25 per day or \$211.25 for the entire week.
