Upon completion of college, Irene began working full time in steno pool, but was transferred to the chief judge position shortly thereafter. After working in the vital statistics department as a clerk and enrollment officer, she was appointed as chief judge, a position she still holds today.

In 1966, he left to go into business for himself but was asked to return to Kah-Nee-Ta as manager for a short time in 1975 until he was promoted to enterprise manager in 1976—as position he held until he was promoted to his present as community services manager.



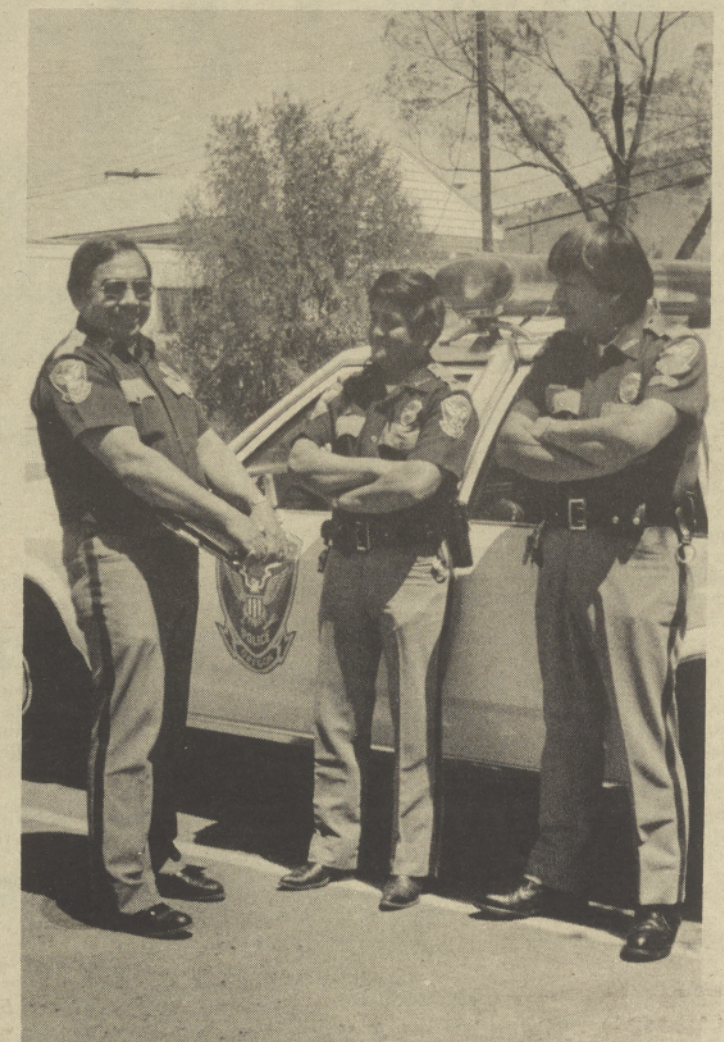
