

IHS accepting applications for scholarship programs

The Indian Health Service (IHS) is now accepting applications for the 1992-93 scholarship cycle for the three scholarship programs authorized by the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (PL 94-437) and its amendments.

Health Profession Preparatory Scholarship Program: This program provides financial assistance for Indian students ONLY to enroll in courses that will prepare them for acceptance into health professions schools. Courses may be either compensatory (required to improve sciences, mathematics, or other basic skills and knowledge) or preprofessional (Required in order to qualify for admission into a health professionals program).

In order for an applicant to be considered for section 103 funding during the 1992-93 cycle, he/she must be accepted by and/or be enrolled in a program beginning in Fall 1992 for one of the following priority categories: 1. Pre-Accounting; 2. Pre-Engineering; 3. Pre-Medical Technology; 4. Pre-Nursing; 5. Pre-Pharmacy; 6. Pre-Physical Therapy; 7. Pre-Sanitation.

Health Professions Pregraduate Scholarship Program: This program provides financial support for Indian students ONLY to enroll in courses leading to a baccalaureate degree in specific preprofessional areas. For the 1992-93 cycle, an applicant must be accepted by and/or enrolled in a program beginning in Fall 1992 for one of the following priority career categories: 1. Pre-Dentistry 2. Pre-Medicine.

Health Professions scholarship Program: This program provides financial support to Indian students ONLY who are enrolled in health professions and allied health professions programs. For the Health Professions Scholarship Program, there are service obligations and payback requirements that the recipient incurs upon acceptance of this particular scholarship. For the 1992-93 cycle, an applicant must be accepted by and/or enrolled in a program beginning in Fall 1992 for one of the following priority career categories: 1. Chemical Dependency Counseling; Masters level only 2. Substance Abuse Services; Masters of Science in Management (MSM) 3. Clinical Psychology; Ph.D degree program only 5. Computer Science; B.S. degree program 6. Dental Hygiene; Associate and B.S. degree programs 7. Dentistry 8. Dietician; B.S. degree program 9. Engineering; Civil, Environmental and Mechanical B.S. degree programs 10. Health Education; Masters level only 11. Health Records; A.R.T. and R.R.T. degree programs 12. Medical Technology; B.S. degree program 13. Medical Social Work; Masters level only 14. Medicine; Allopathic and Osteopathic 15. Nurse Practitioner; R.N. A., C.N.M. and F.N. P. 16. Nursing; A.D.N., B.S.N., and M.S.N. (Priority consideration will be given to registered nurses employed by the Indian Health Service; in a program assisted under a contract entered into under the Indian Self-Determination Act; or in a program assisted under

title V of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act.) 17. Optometry 18. Pharmacy; B.S. degree program 19. Physician Assistant; B.S. degree program 20. Physical Therapy 21. Public Health; M.P.H. degree program only. (Applicants must be enrolled or accepted in a school of public health and must have two years of health delivery experience.) 22. Public Health Nutrition; Masters level only 23. Radiologic Technology 24. Sanitarian; Environmental Health, Environmental Science and Occupational Safety and Health B.S. degree programs 25. Sonography 26. Accounting; B.S. degree program 27. Para-Optometric.
