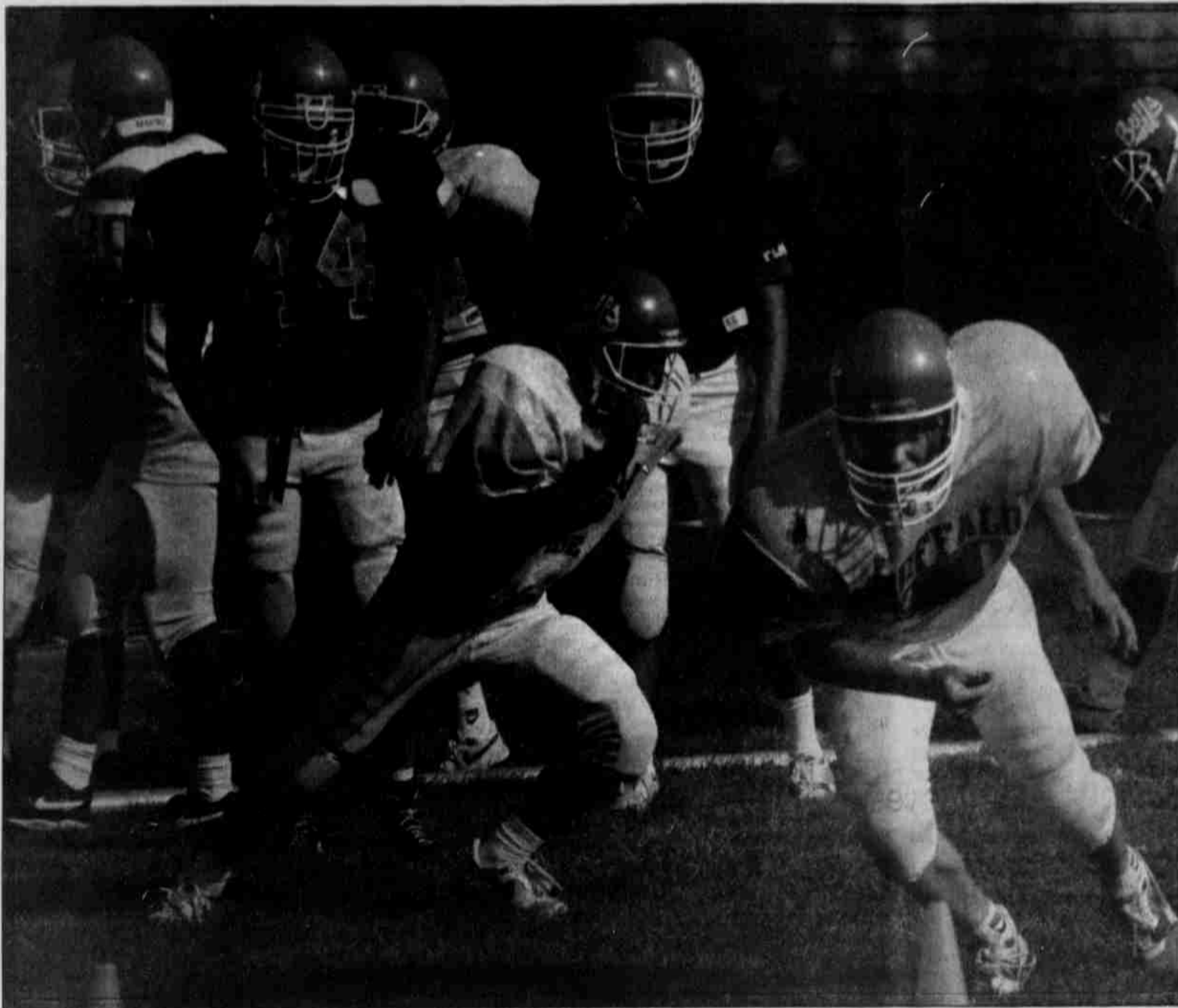

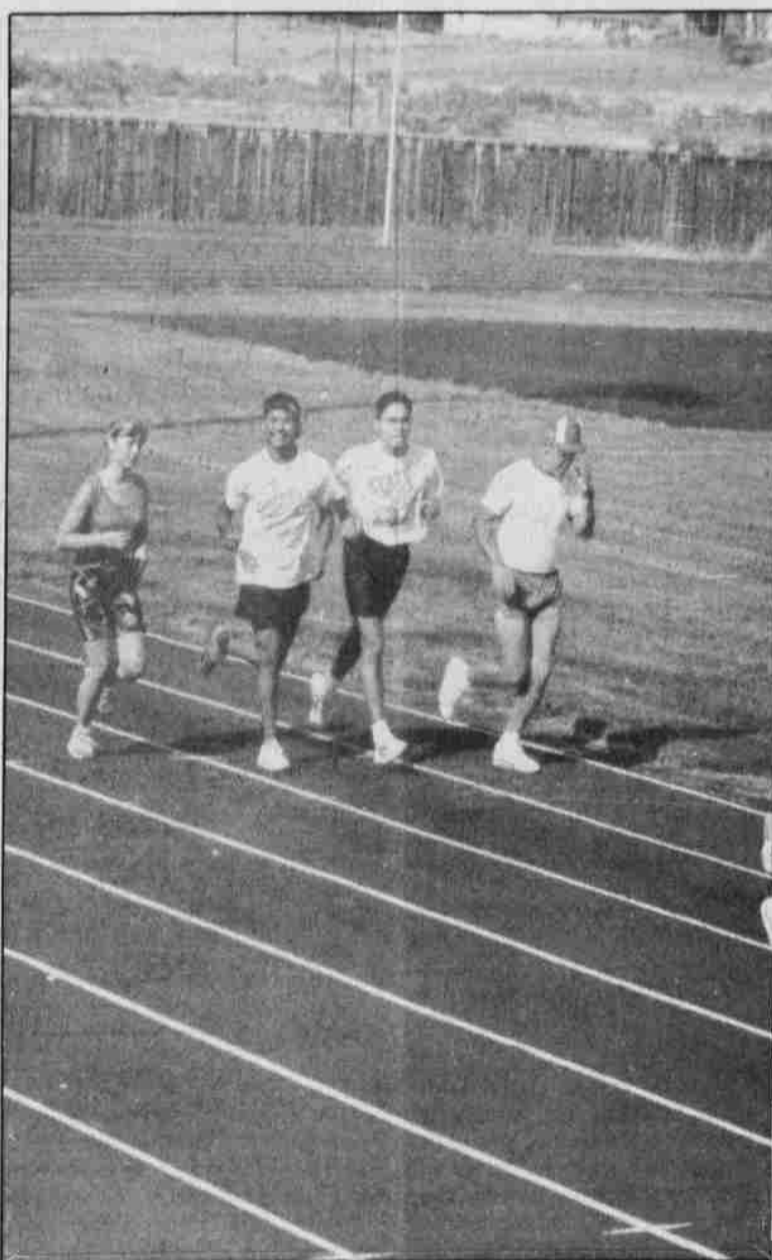
Southern Ute Tribal Fair to be held September 11-13 in Ignacio, CO
