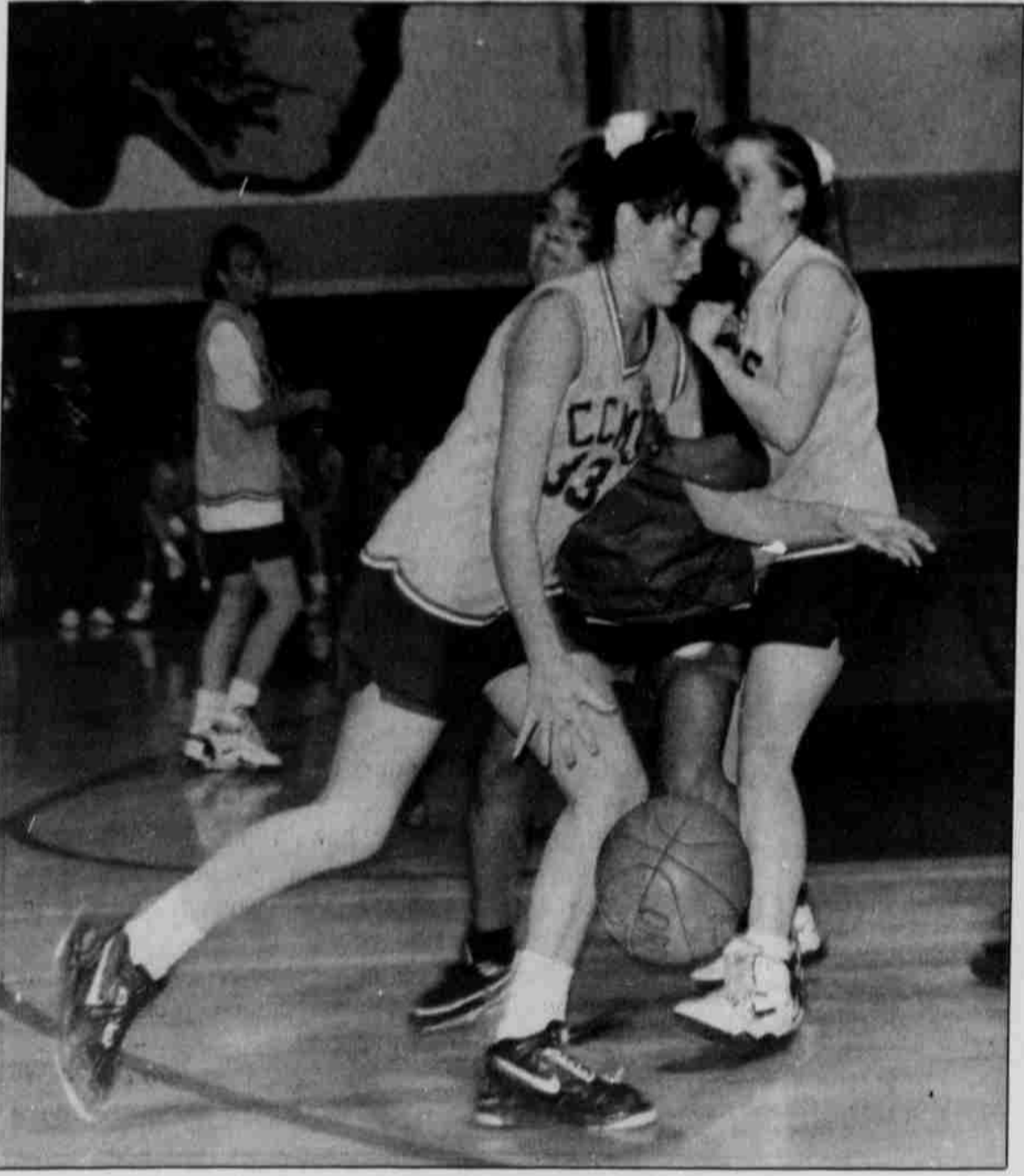

 There would be big savings budget wise as it would cut down in travel. It has been reported in the past

that the farthest trip in the Tri-Valley league would be to Banks, Oregon, which is west of Portland yet it would be closer than the shortest trip in the GOL, which is Burns. The GOL Schools all have about a 4 to 5 hour travel period and that covers a lot of miles.
