Old timers get ready for rodeo

There is an Old Timers Rodeo for 40 years and older cowboys on August 18, 1993 put on by the Crow Agency. This is the 3rd annual rodeo for the big boys who will be vying for an All-Around saddle and championship buckles.

There will be \$200.00 put up for each event with the entry fee of \$40.00 per entry and a \$5.00 stock fee and a \$2.50 Secretary charge, making the total of \$47.50 for some of the events. The order of events are Century Roping (enter 3 times), \$40.00 per man \$5.00 stock fee \$2.50 Sec. Fee total of \$47.50. Calf roping the entry will be the same with the total of \$47.50. In the Ribbon roping purse of \$200.00, entry fee \$50.00, stock fee \$5.00 and Sec. fee \$5.00, total of \$60.00. Bull dogging the entry fee

will be \$47.50. Team roping, a person can enter three times, total of \$47.50 per man. In the Girls Barrel racing \$40.00 entry fee no stock charge \$2.50 Sec. charge. with a total of \$42.50.

Contestant must enter 2 events or more to qualify for the All-Around. Entering booth team ropings will qualify for the all-around. First to enter, last to rope.
