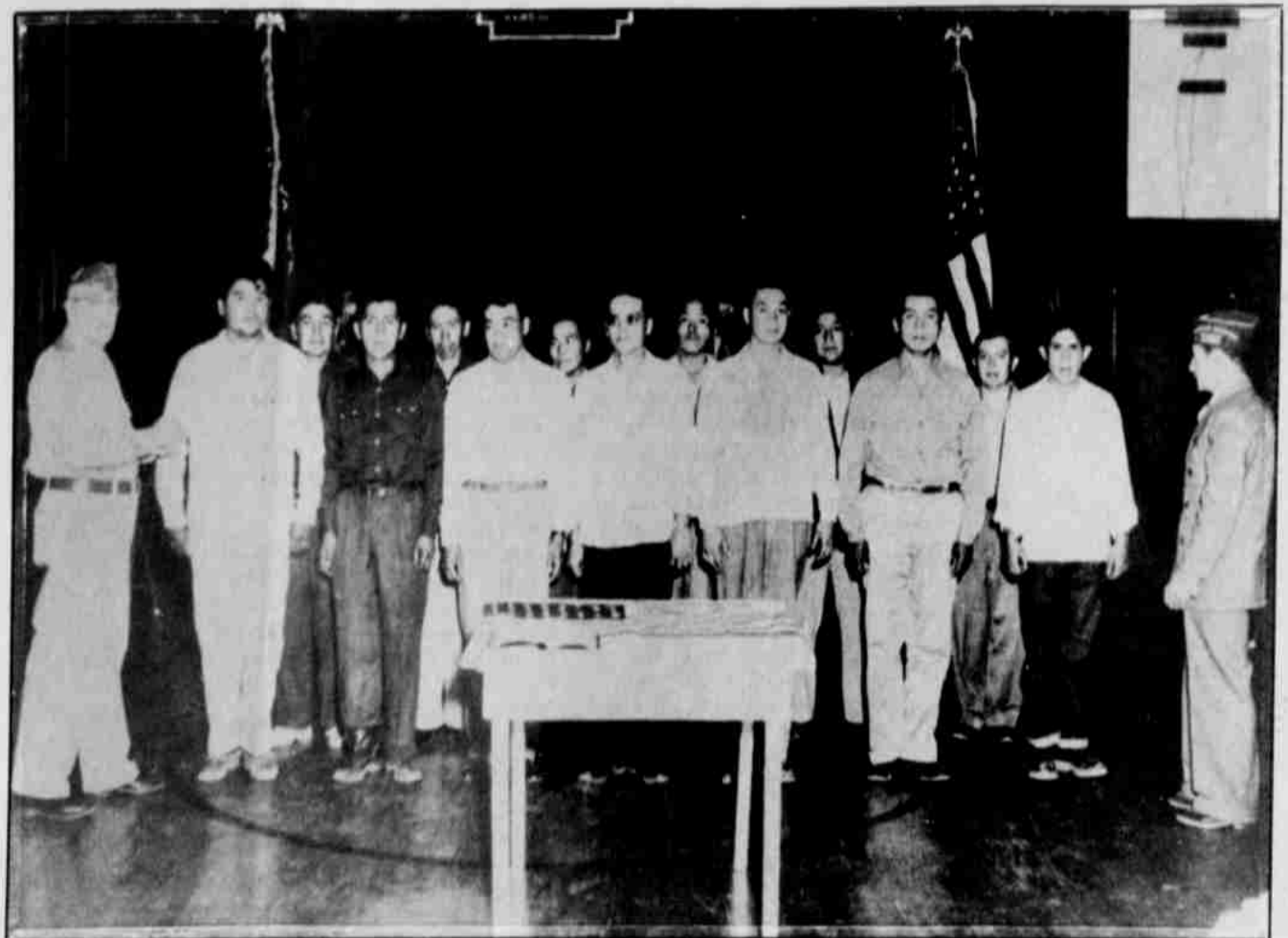


Local veterans show their pride, patriotism by serving country when called

Korean vets get their own day

Veterans Day has been observed annually since World War I to honor men and women killed in American wars. It originated as Armistice Day to commemorate the end of World War I. After World War II it was recognized as a day of tribute to that war too. In 1954, after the Korean conflict, the date was officially designated in the United States as Veterans Day to honor servicemen of all US wars. On July 27 of this year, at the dedication of the Korean War Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., President Clinton signed Public Law 10419, the FY 1995 Rescissions Act, which designates

July 27 as "National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day." Proponents of the Public Law say the law extends the recognition of Korean War veterans' service and sacrifice all the way from the Mall in Washington, D.C. to the flag pole of the local post office. "We can only hope that Korean War veterans all over the country will take advantage of this law to commemorate those who served in the Korean War, especially the dead and the missing." Sixty members of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs were enlisted in the military during the 1950s.
