**Resort vendor regs noted**

Kah-Nee-Ta Resort recently released this season's vendors' rules and regulations. They are as follows:  
**1. Qualifications:**  
 Licensee must be 21 years of age. Licensee must be a tribal member.  
 Immediate family members may be authorized, i.e., spouse, daughter or son. However, authorized sellers must be listed on the application at time of completion.  
**2. Location and time:**  
 Licenses will be issued for the period running from May 1 through October 30 of each year. Set up will be in the walkway.  
**3. Limit:**  
 The space is limited to six vendors daily and is on a first come basis.

- 4. Fee:**  
 a. A yearly fee of \$20 is charged per vendor.  
 b. Vendors will furnish their own supplies.  
 c. One table not to exceed 21/2' by 8' may be set up along with chairs.  
 d. Table must be skirted to hide any boxes or crafts stored under the table.  
 e. Table and chairs must be torn down and taken home daily.  
**5. Parking:**  
 Vendor parking will be in the upper parking level and to the right of the driveway.  
**6. Items to be sold:**  
 All items must have been made locally. (Beadwork, crafts and art.) Items not made locally will not be allowed.  
**7. License may be purchased Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the personnel office and must be displayed.** Vendors with proper identification will be approved immediately. All others will have to wait for verification through tribal administration.

**Tribal Council announces Board vacancies**

The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs announces the following board vacancies: Warm Springs Gaming Enterprise (1 position), Warm Springs Credit Enterprise (5 positions) and Warm Springs Power Enterprise (1 position).  
 Following are the descriptions of each of the board positions:  
**Warm Springs Gaming Enterprise: Board of Directors (1 Position—Class II)**  
 Article III General Powers  
 Section 3. Qualifications. Each member of the Board of Directors shall meet the qualifications and shall be subject to the same licensing requirements as are set forth in IGRA, the Compact and the Gaming Ordinance for a key management employee.  
 Section 4. Classification and Term of Office  
 (a) The Board of Directors shall be divided into three classes, designated Class I, Class II and Class III, as follows:  
 (2) Class II shall consist of two individuals, one of whom shall be a member of the Tribe and one of whom shall be a non-member of the Tribe who is interested in the economic and social development of the Tribe and its membership and who possesses expertise in gaming, accounting, law, law enforcement, computers or some other field which would benefit WSGE. Class II directors shall have an initial term in office expiring one year after the expiration of the initial term of the Class I director, or until their successors are appointed and take office.  
 Section 9. Regular meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held quarterly on the first Monday in the months of February, May, August and November for the purpose of reviewing the preceding three months' operations, making plans for the ensuring three months' operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting. The first regular meeting in each fiscal year shall also be the annual meeting of the Board of Directors. At the annual meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board of Directors shall review the preceding year's operations, make plans for the ensuing year's operations, elect officers and transact such other business as may come before the meeting. The regular meetings shall be held at the time and place specified by the Chair of the Board in the notice of the meeting. If the day fixed for a regular meeting falls on a tribal holiday, or is otherwise inconvenient or unsatisfactory in

**Tribal Credit Enterprise Board of Directors (5 positions)**  
 Section 1. Establishment of the Tribal Credit Enterprise Board of Directors. There is hereby established a Tribal Credit Board of Director consisting of five (5) members to be appointed by the Tribal Council in accordance with the provisions of this Charter. All credit activities of The Enterprise will be under the supervisory review and direction of this Board of Directors.  
 Section 2. Classification and Term of Office of the Board of Directors  
 1) The members of the Board of Directors shall be divided into three classes, designated Class I, Class II and Class III as follows:  
 a) Class I shall consist of two directors. One director shall be an enrolled member of the Tribes. The other Class I director shall be a non-member interested in the social and economic development of the Tribes and who has expertise in the field of credit or related professions. The Class I directors shall have an initial term in office expiring January 1, 1997.  
 b) Class II shall consist of two directors. One director will be an enrolled member of the Tribes. The other Class II director shall be a non-member interested in the social and economic development of the Tribes, and who has expertise in the field of credit or related professions. The Class II directors shall have an initial term in office expiring January 1, 1998.  
 c) Class III shall consist of one member, who shall be an enrolled member of the Tribes. The Class III director shall have an initial term in office expiring January 1, 1999 or until their successors are appointed and take office.  
 2) Selection of Board of Directors. The first five members will be appointed for terms of one, two and three years. At the end of the first year and each year thereafter, as each term of office expires, the term of office will be for three years. Members will continue to serve until their successors are appointed.  
 3) Record of Appointments. A record of all appointments to the Board of Directors will be maintained by the Secretary/Treasurer of the Tribal Council.  
 4) Members of the Board of Directors must have a reputation for industry, dependability, honesty and integrity. It shall be an initial and continuing qualification for members of the Board of Directors that they have no loan with the Tribes that is in a delinquent status.

No decrease in the number of directors shall have the effect of shortening the term of office of any incumbent directors.  
 Section 2. Classification and Term of Office

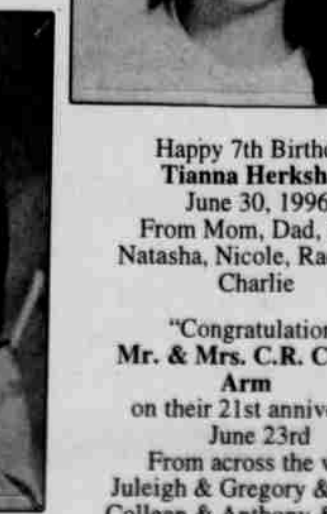
