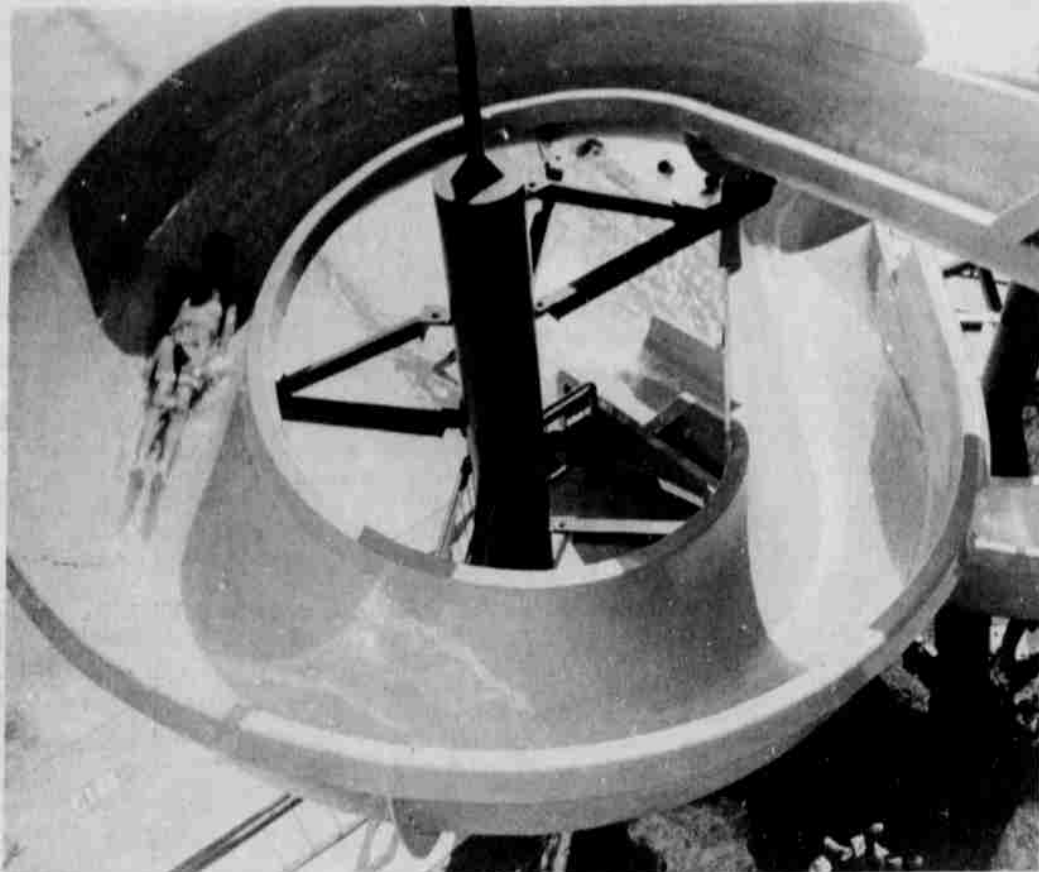
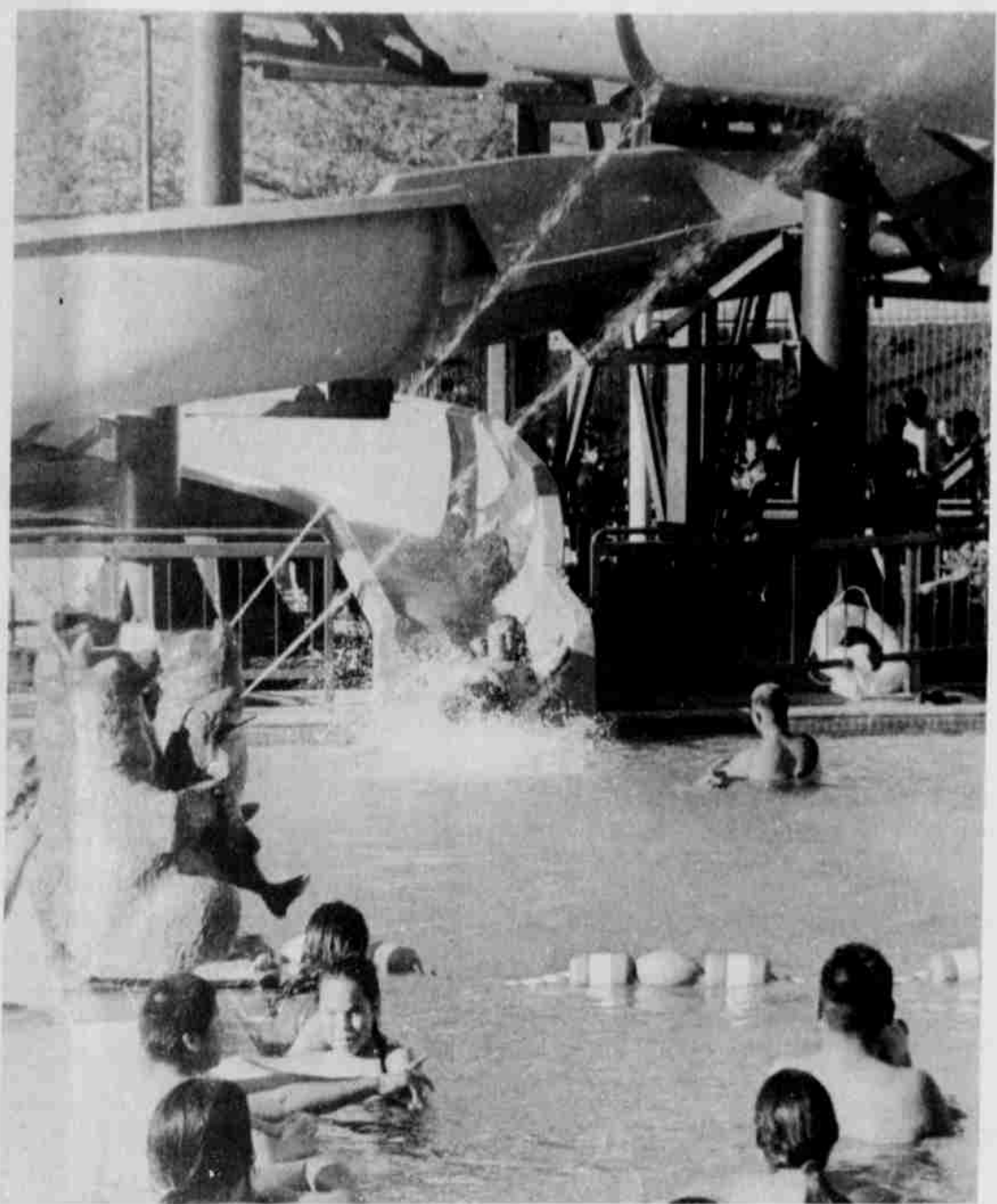

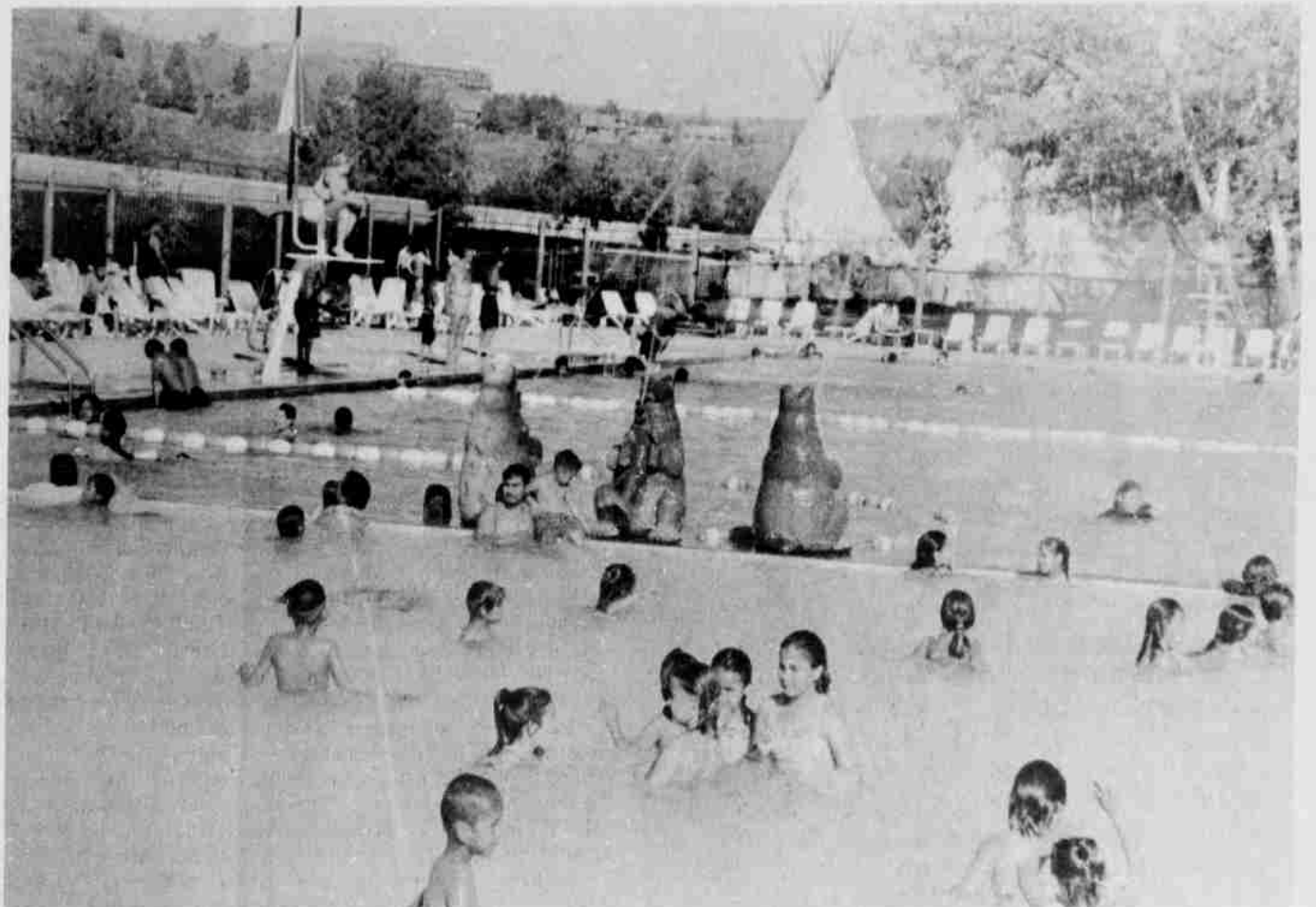
Spiraling downward toward the pool, young boy enjoys fast trip.



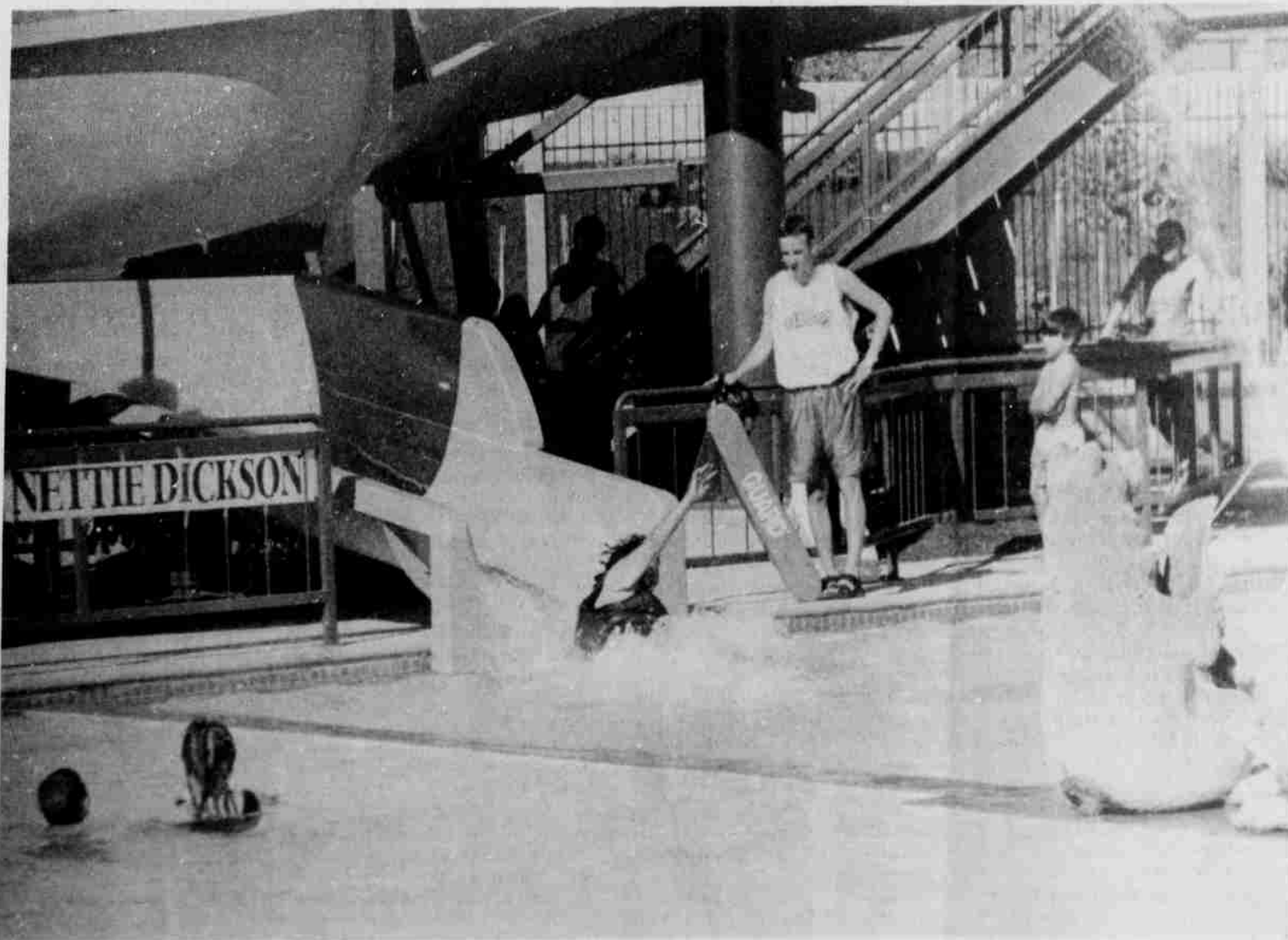
Hamilton Greeley braved the new 50-foot slide. He later jokingly said he "nearly drowned" as he hit the bottom.
