You will be our future leaders.

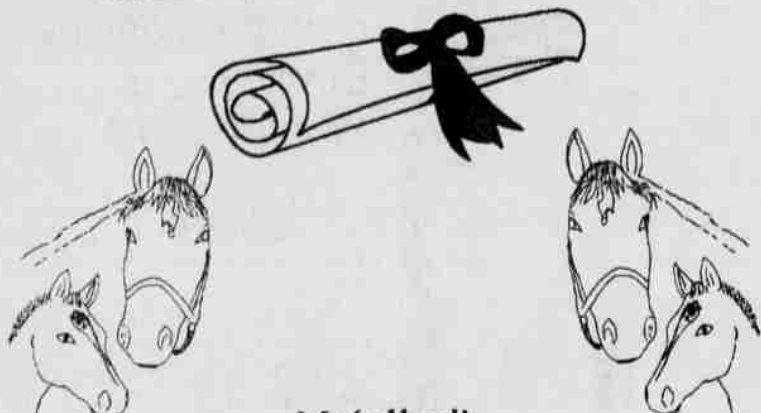

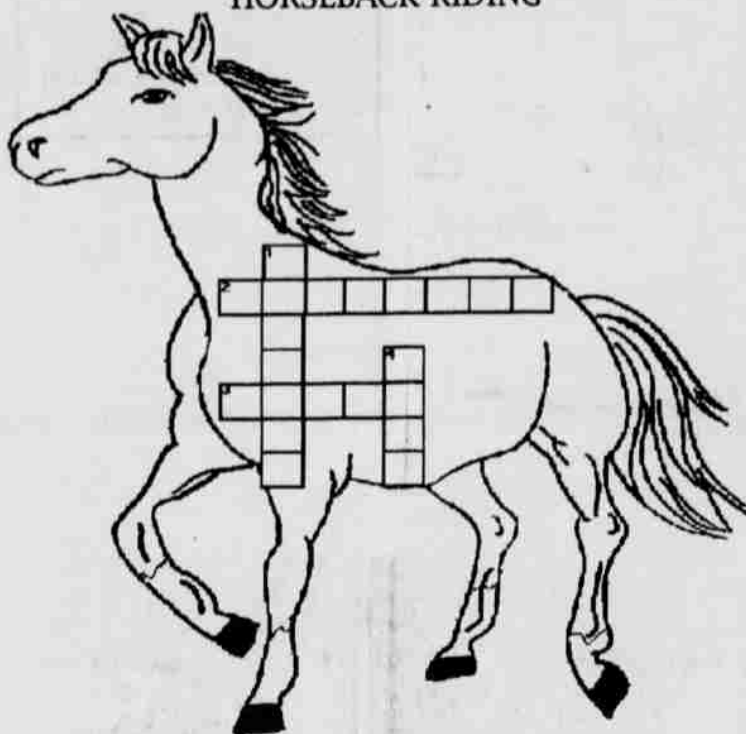
