

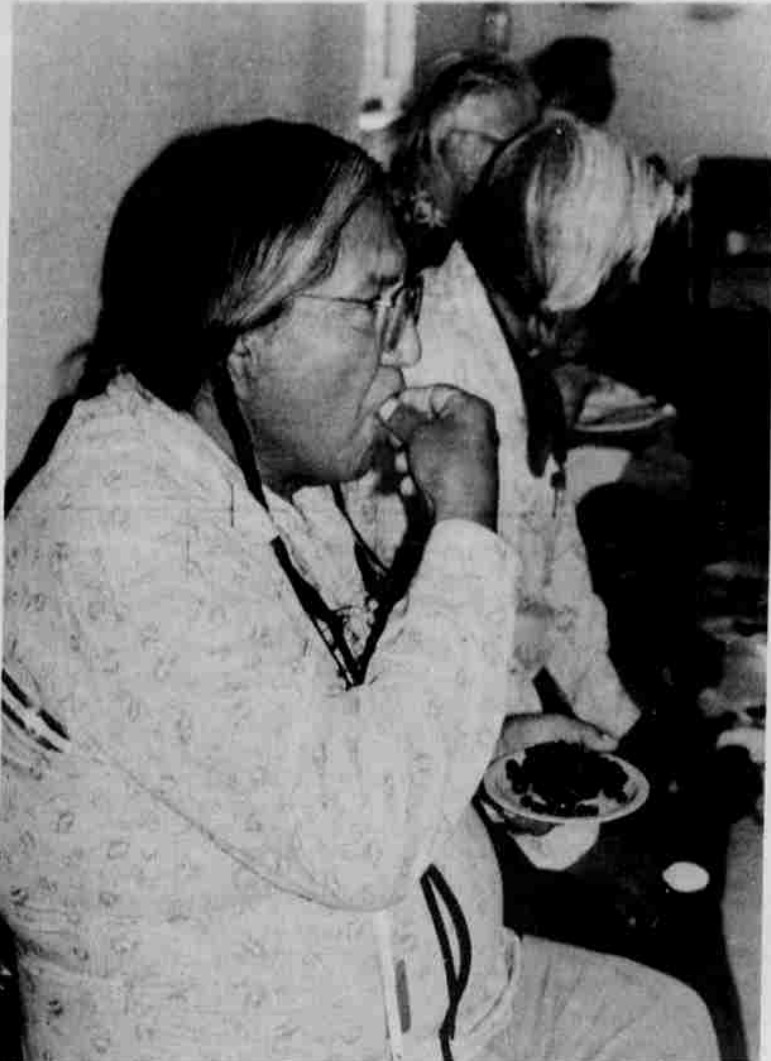
Annual Feast = A "berry" good time



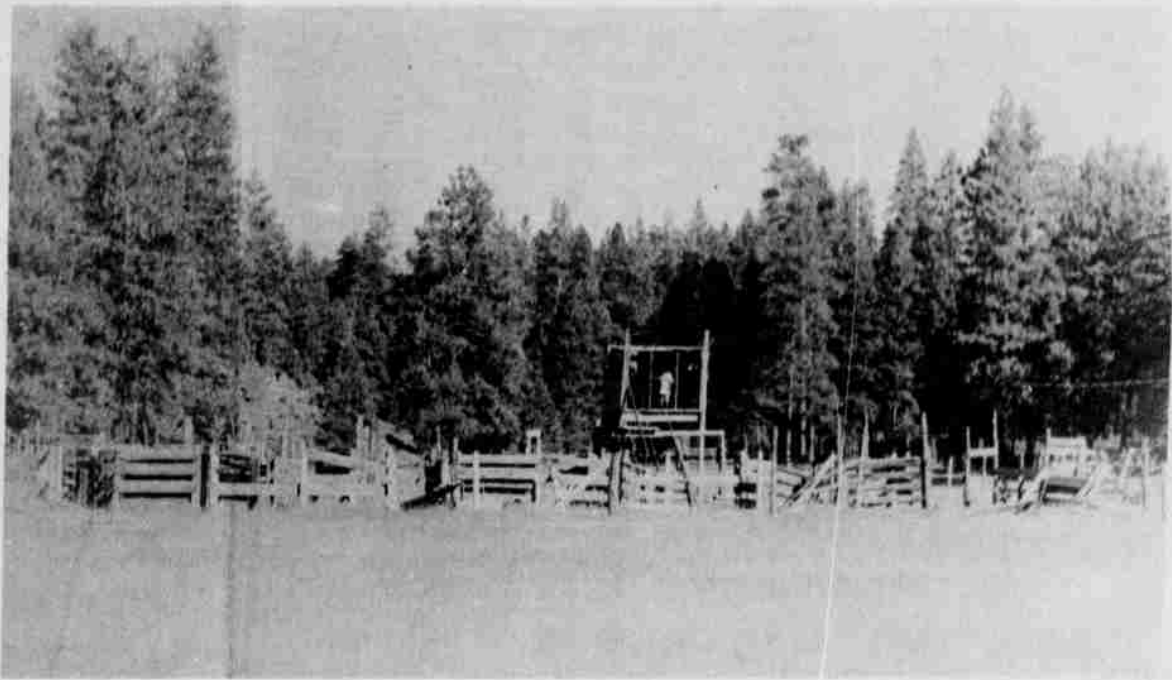
Riggs Charley, Harrison Davis and Levi "Schnoz" Kennedy were among the first to get their food to sit down and enjoy.



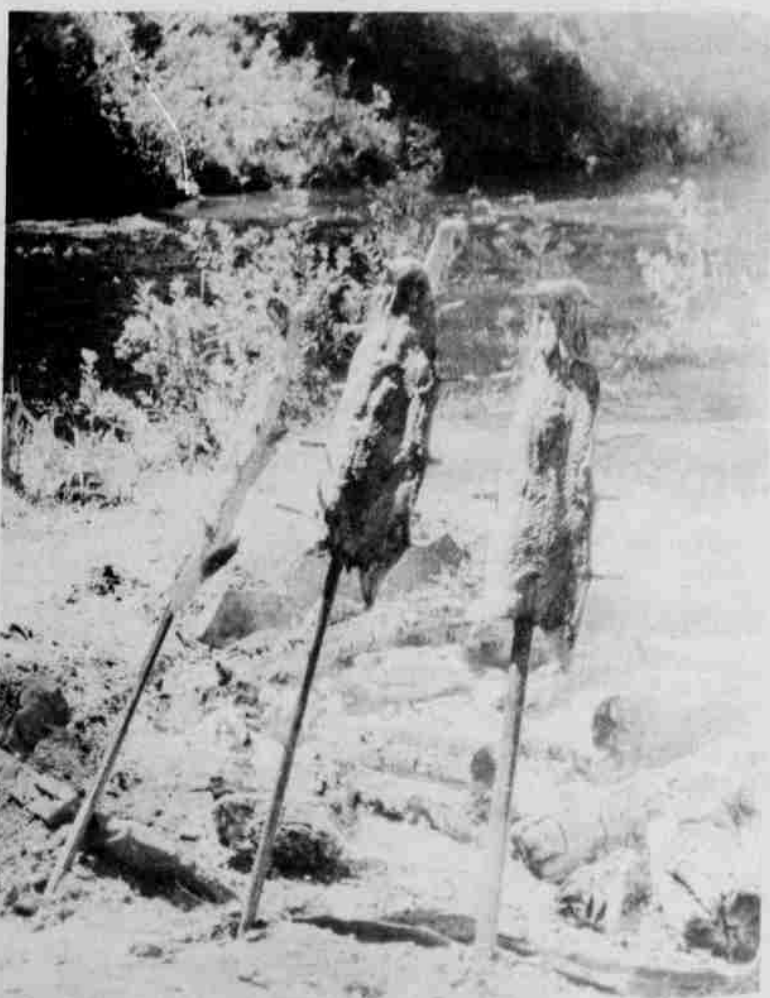
Young lady from The Dalles waded into the water to cool off.



Nathan "8 Ball" Jim sat down and ate huckleberries first. Then the other good food.

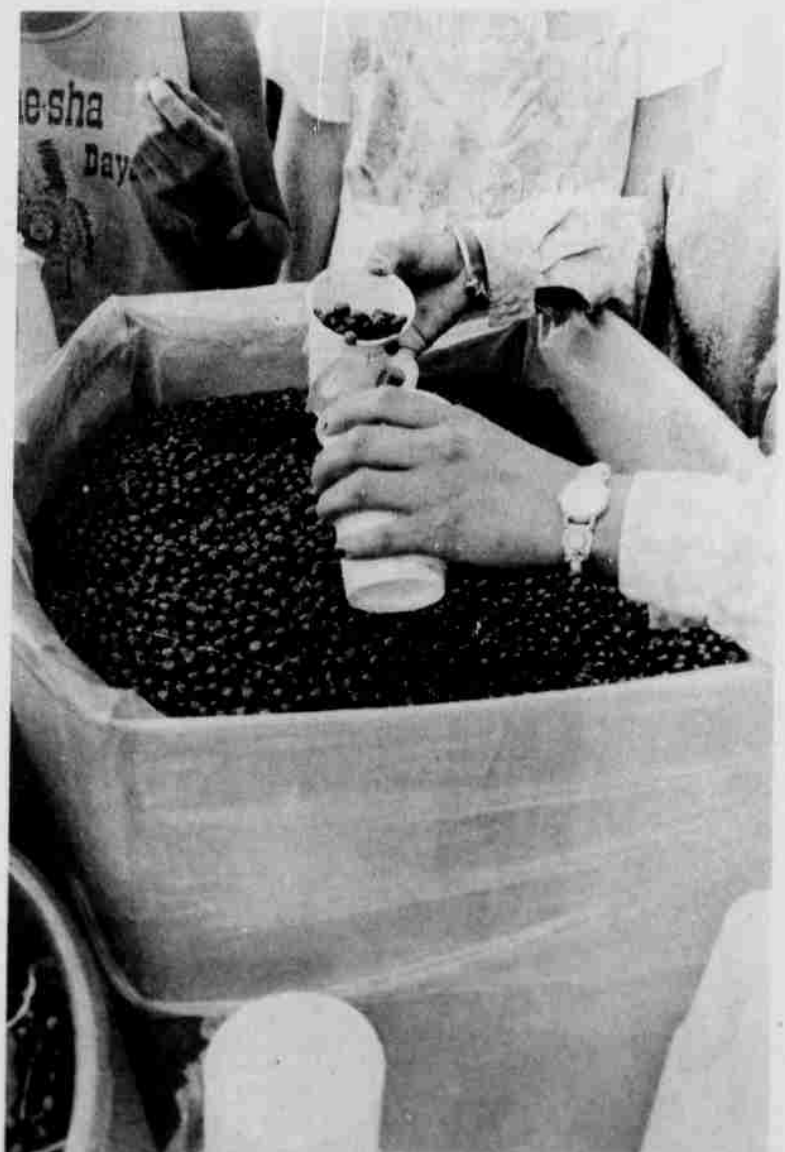
