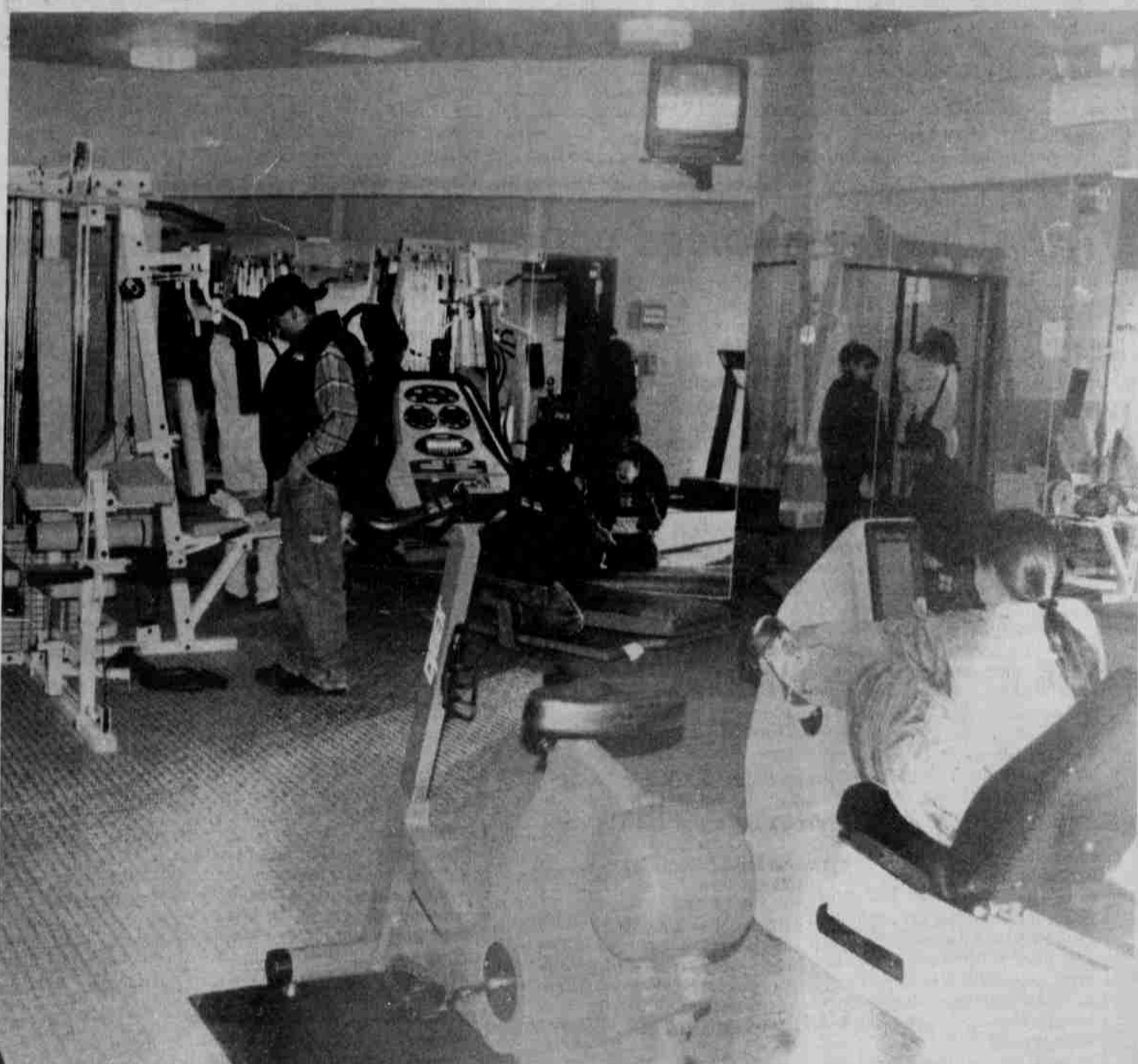
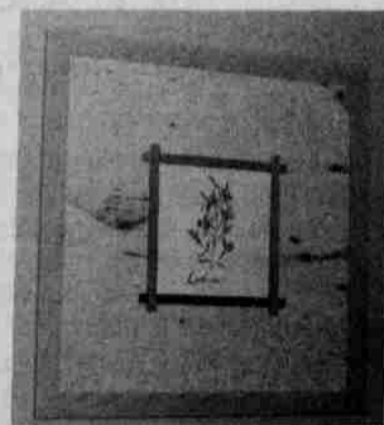


Grand opening ceremonies held for Spa Wanapine at the Kah-Nee-Ta Village

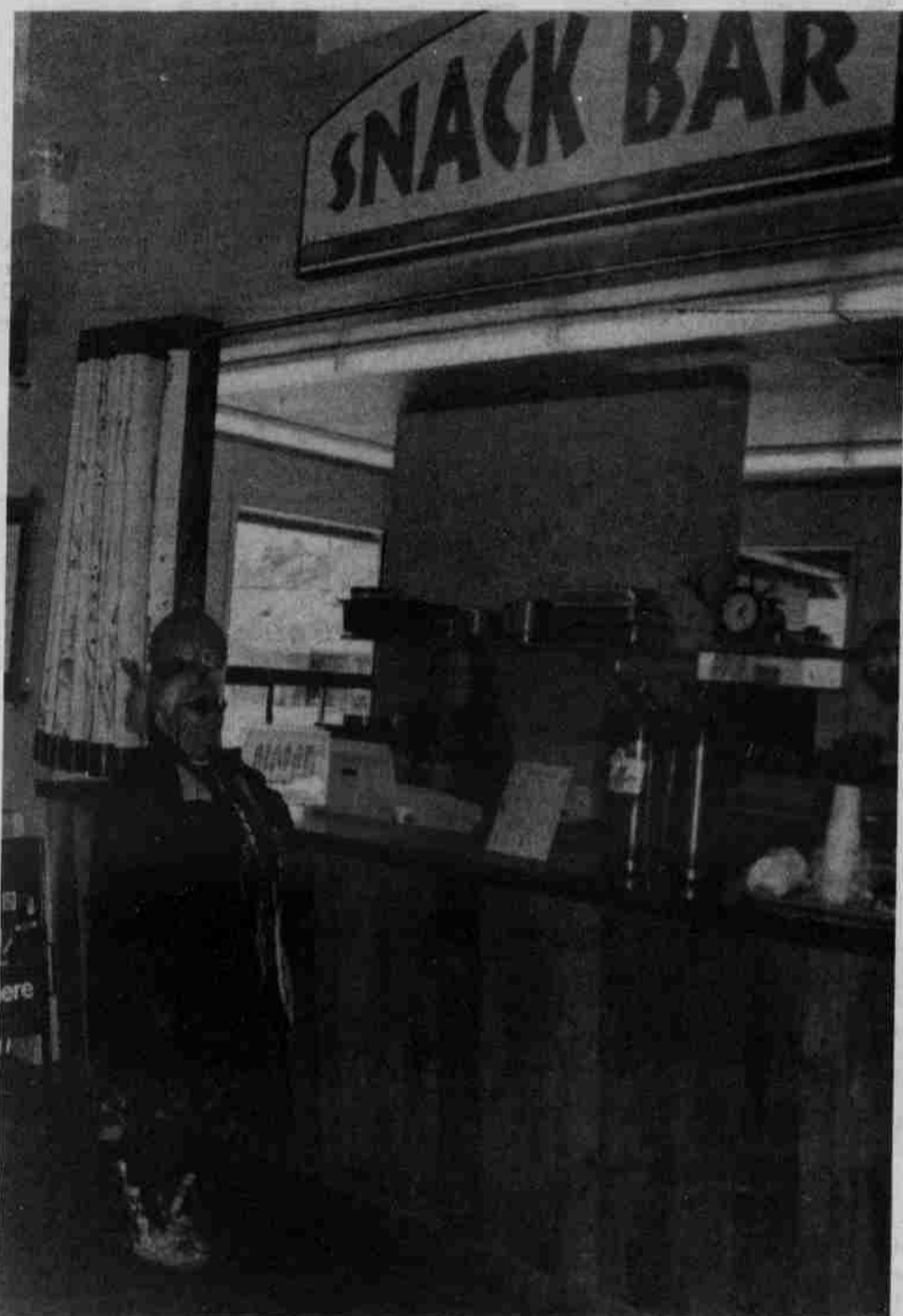


The latest in circuit training equipment located in the spa.

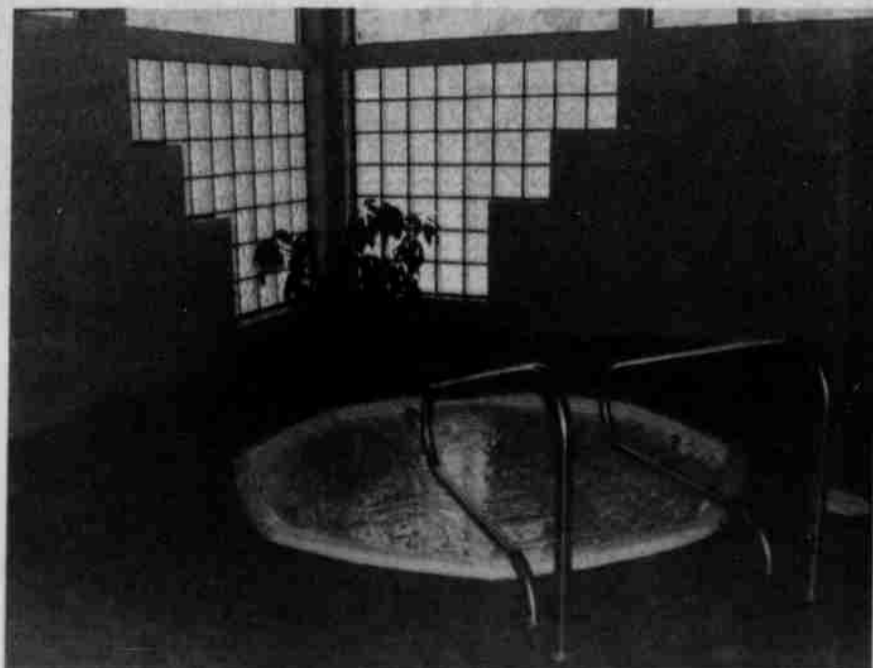
Fourth grade students from Warm Springs Elementary painted pictures on tiles. These pictures are located throughout Spa Wanapine.
