Yeah right!

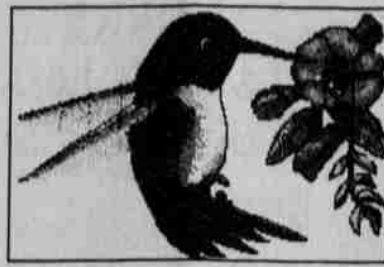
Tubetse!

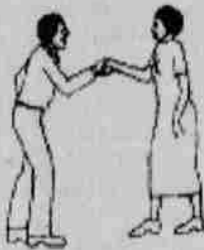

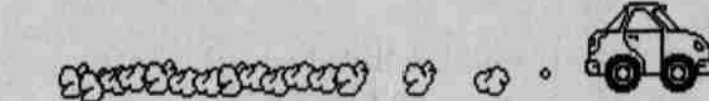
