

Kah-Nee-Ta offers management training for employees

Kah-Nee-Ta's management training program was created for advancement of Tribal members to management positions here at the Resort. Kah-Nee-Ta tries to maintain trainees at all times. They currently have one graduate, Carlos Smith, Rooms Division Manager, Gerald Sampson, Jr., in his second year and will be moving to the Food and Beverage Department in September. The third and newest trainee is Scott Moses. Scott put the program on hold this year to take a position as village Gate Manager. He will be moving to the accounting department this winter.

A Kah-Nee-Ta trainee signs on for a period of three years and will work in the various departments of the resort. This enables the trainee to find which area of management he/she will pursue. While Kah-Nee-Ta does not guarantee a management position after three years, the trainee

has the option of staying at Kah-Nee-Ta working up to a management position of his/her choice, or accepting another position that may be open. If the trainee elects to leave the reservation, Kah-Nee-Ta will help him/her find a position off the reservation in the hospitality business.

Kah-Nee-Ta has been advertising for a management trainee for another position this summer. Receiving only two applicants, the position has remained open in hopes of attracting ambitious Tribal members to apply. This Management Trainee position will close on September 25, 1998. Readjustment Counseling

Vet Centers provide counseling to Vietnam-era women and men who have difficulty adjusting to civilian life.

Disability Compensation

Veterans who are disabled by injury or disease incurred or aggravated during active service in line of duty during wartime or peacetime service and were discharged or separated under other than dishonorable conditions may be compensated for their service-connected injury or disease. Veterans who are found to be eligible for disability compensation are entitled to monthly payments. The amount of payment depends upon the degree of amount of disability. In addition, a wide variety of benefits, including specially adapted auto and homes, are available certain severely disabled veterans.

evaluation, independent living services, educational or vocational training, or employment assistance is needed Veterans who are seriously disabled may receive services and assistance to improve their ability to live more independently in their community. After completion of training, the VA will assist the veteran to find and hold a suitable job.

Home Loans

Veterans with sufficient active-duty service, women and men alike, may obtain VA-guaranteed loans to purchase or improve houses, manufactured homes and condominiums.

Death Benefits

Veterans may be buried in a VA National Cemetery, along with spouses and minor children. Veterans, men and women, are eligible for a plot allowance and those receiving disability compensation or pension payment also are eligible for burial allowances. VA will also furnish a flag and a headstone or marker to mark the grave of a veteran buried in a national, state or private cemetery.

Employment

There are various benefits available to veterans and their dependents which are not administered by the Department of Veterans Affairs. For more information, contact the Veterans' Employment Service of the Department of Labor.

How to obtain VA benefits:

Benefits are not automatically available. For specific eligibility information, contact the nearest VA Regional Office or VA Medical Center. There is a women's coordinator in each regional office and medical center to help you. Look for U.S. Government, Department of Veterans Affairs, in phone directories. Toll-free service is available in all 50 states.



Education

VA administers education programs for veterans and active duty servicepersons. Veterans who participated in the Montgomery G.I. Bill also provides educational assistance to members of the selected Reserve. Spouses and children of the deceased or seriously disabled women veterans as well as men veterans also may be eligible for VA educational assistance.

Vocational Rehabilitation

Veterans who served in Armed Forces during World War II or thereafter and suffered a service connected disability in active service which entitles them to compensation may be eligible for vocational rehabilitation. A disabled veteran will be given an initial evaluation to establish an initial evaluation to establish eligibility and entitlement and to determine whether extended
