One (1) antlerless elk per family ( 100 tags available) Must exchange unused bull tag to receive an antlerless tag First come, first served. Only to hunters that have not fille their bull tag and only antlerless elk may be harvested. No designated hunting allowed on these tags.

One (1) bear per family except cubs \& sows with cubs are

Grouse-3 per day
Quail-10 per day
Chukar-10 per day
Migratory birds: Ducks, Geese, Mourning Dove Bag limits \& season established under the Migratory Bird
Treaty Act. Seasons \&

Hunting of birds limited to shotguns, archery \& pistol fired shot shell.
