Again!

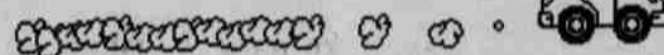
Sagra manewunne!

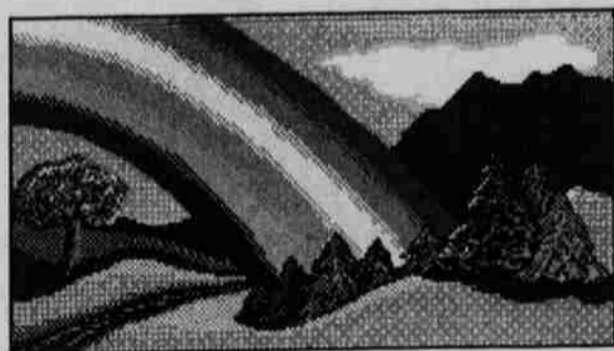
