The safety program, America Buckles Up Children, reports that car accidents are the leading cause of accidental death and injury among children 14 and younger; 1,700 children are killed every year and another 300,000 injured. 1) They believe it's safer for children not to wear seat belts so they+II be thrown from the vehicle in a crash. They don't realize that 75 percent of those thrown out of cars die
