My white coat has four pockets.

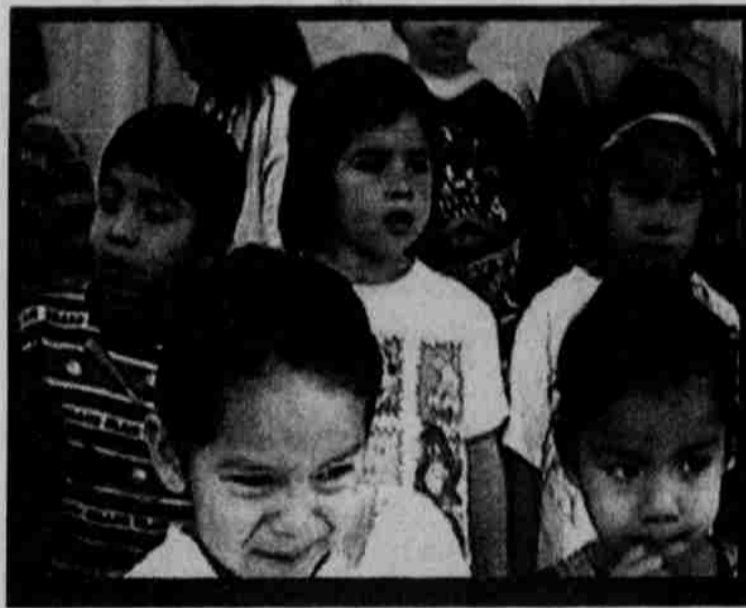
Osoo poohe kwasu tumu.
