It's cold outside.

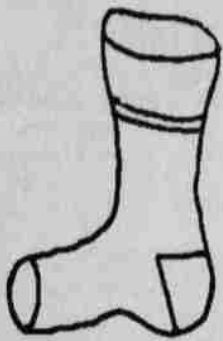
Áuna lq'iwitasha amchnikan.

Here's my hat.

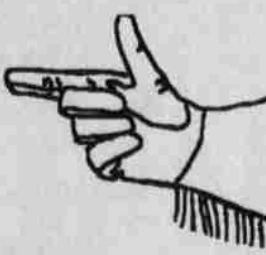


Chishwa lq'um

Put your sock on.

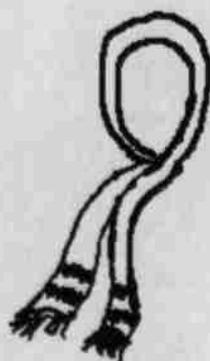
Q'pq'pplik

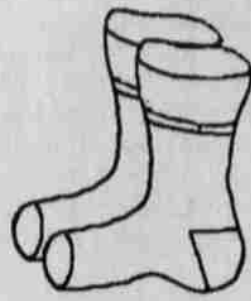

Everyone put your shoes on.

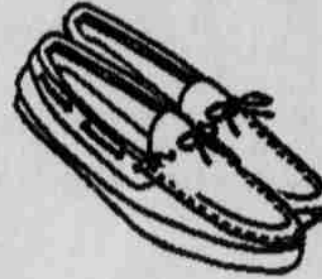
Witq'umiti
