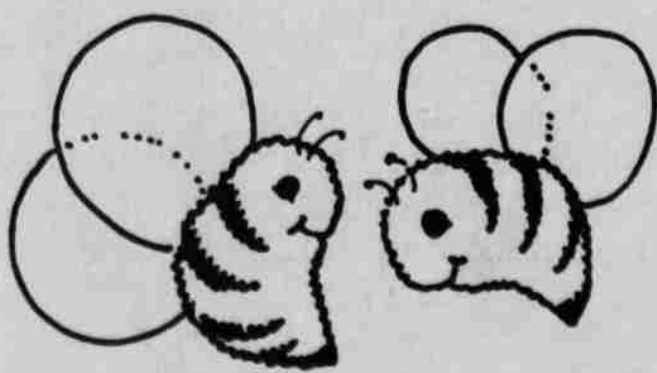
Toisu pesa natoize
