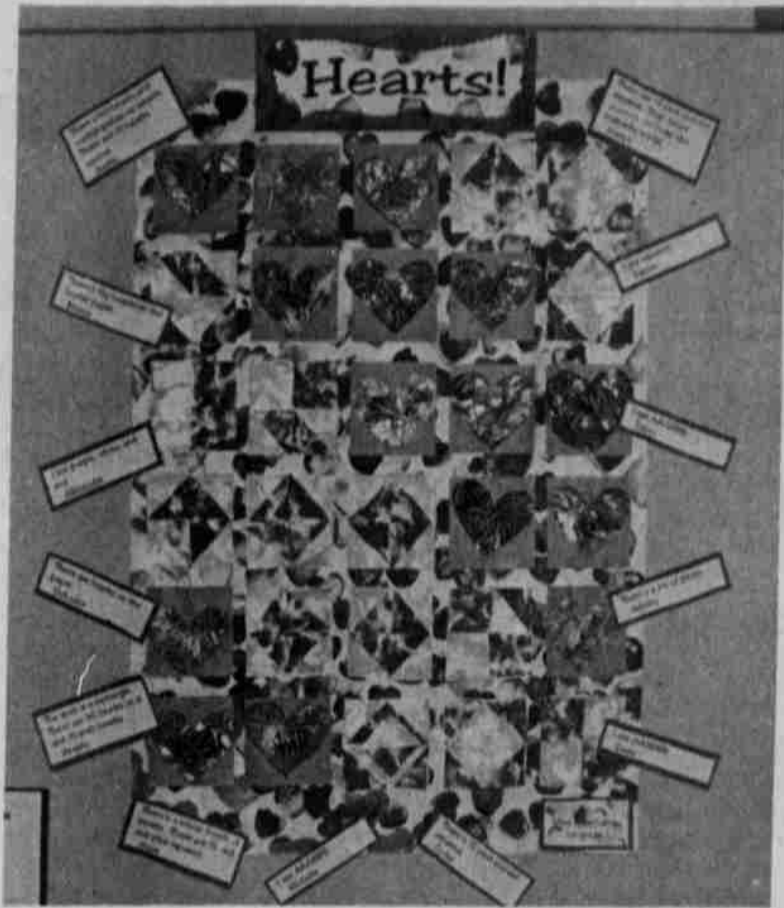


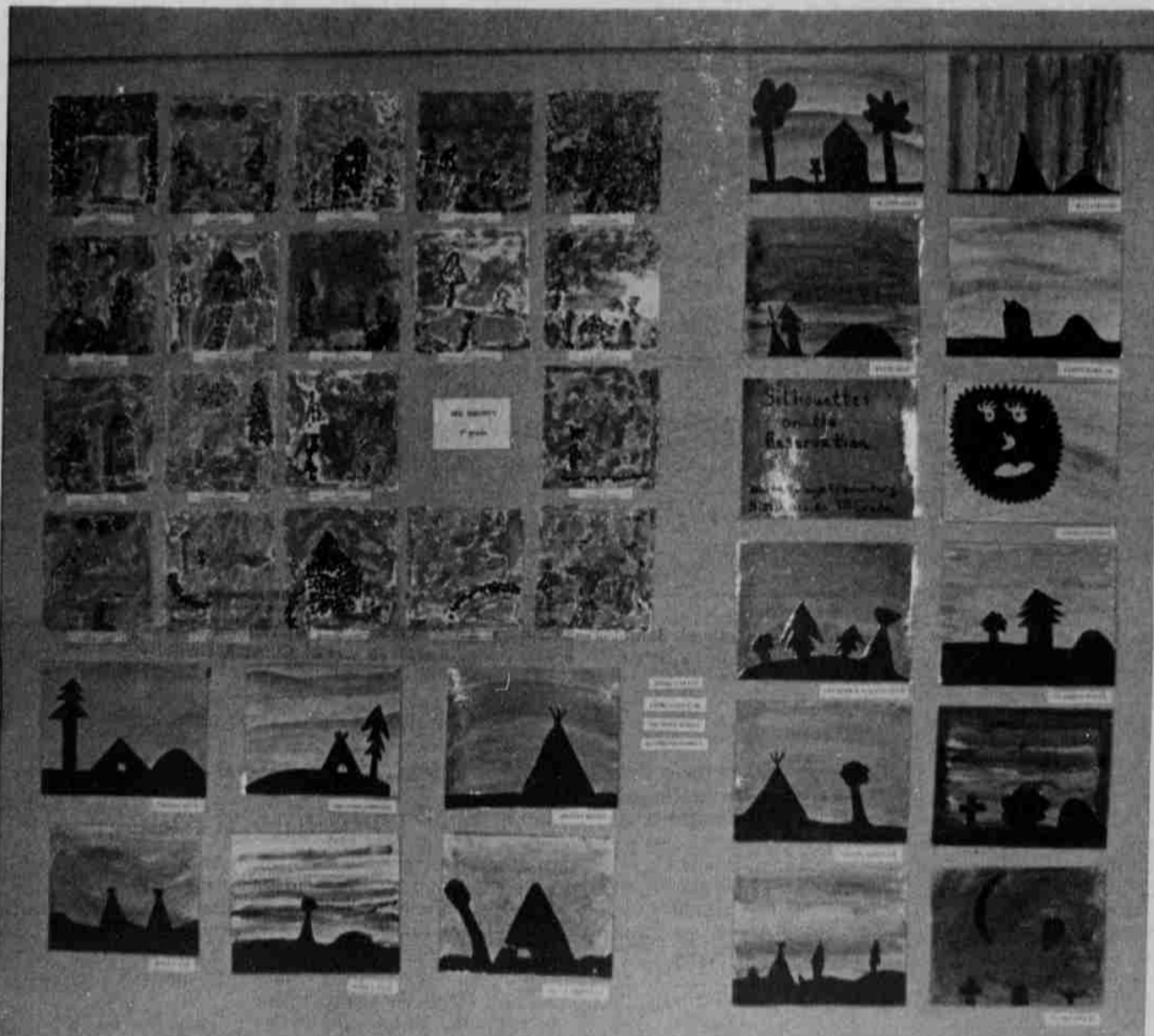

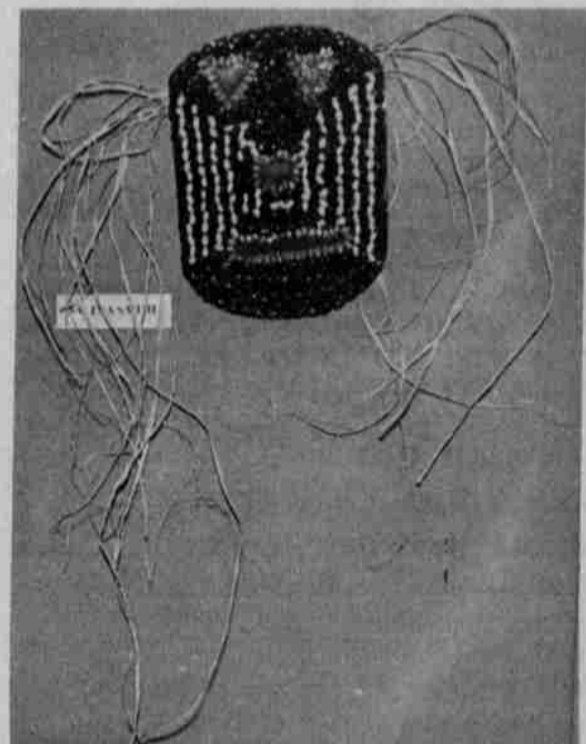

Heart quilt.



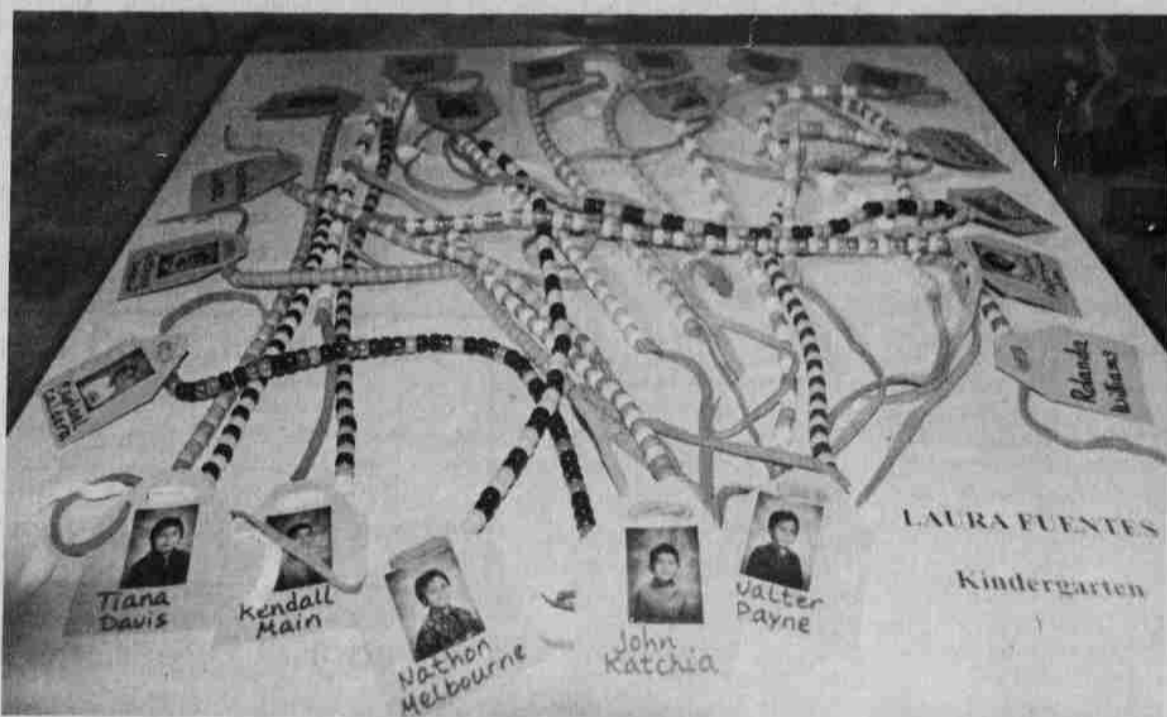
Silhouettes on the Reservation by Fourth grade.
