I love all children

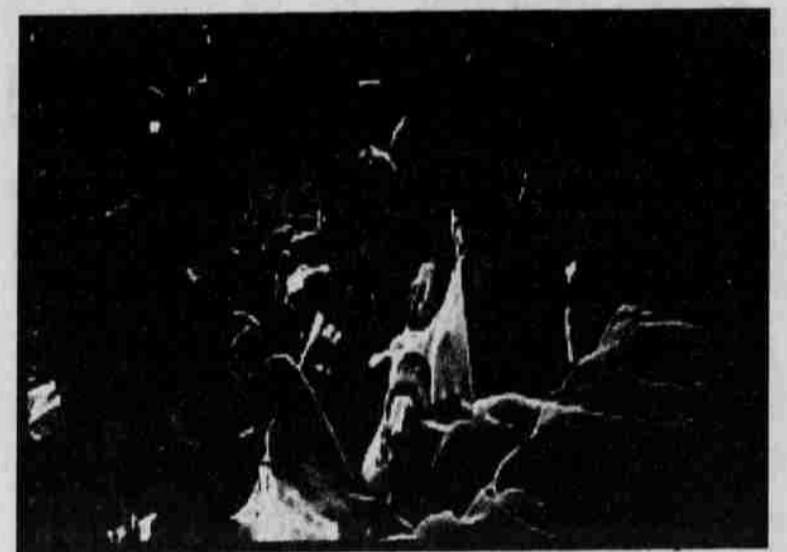


A Mother's Day Poem In Kiksht
