



# It's A Law Senate Bill 690 Signed by Governor Kitzhaber

Our program had initiated Senate Bill 690 -Teacher Certification for Native American Language Teacher January 5, 2001 and has been involved with the initiative until recently signed by Governor Kitzhaber, June 27, 2001, making it a new law for Oregon.

3/18/01 Full Senate Floor Passed 28 - 0

05/10/01 House Education Committee Passed 6 - 0

05/22/01 Full House Floor Passed 48 - 0

06/27/01 Governor Signing of Bill Made Law
