## Flu vaccines offered on several dates

It's almost that time of year again. You know, the time when sniffles and coughs and cols are everywhere.

Those pesky germs are passed through the community on hands, sneeze droplets and coughs.

You can help prevent these germs from latching onto you and prevent passing them onto others by washing your hands often using soap and water. Always sneeze into a Kleenex or handkerchief. And make sure you turn your head when you cough.

One of the best ways to prevent catching the flu is to have a flu shot. Even if you had a shot last year you need another one this fall, since the type of flu germs it protects against are different each year. The flu season in the U.S. is from November to March or April, and a shot taken in the fall will protect you for the entire season.

This year the clinic is vaccinating high risk persons beginning in October. This includes all persons age 65 and older, persons of any age with chronic medical conditions such as asthma and diabetes, women who will be more than 3 months pregnant during the flu season, and household members of persons in high-risk groups.

In November, Public Health Nursing will hold several clinics at various locations on the reservation for persons at lower risk.

Flu vaccine is recommended for anyone over age 50. You may come to any site that is most convenient for you.

There is no charge and an appointment is not necessary. Anyone who is eligible to receive care at the Indian Health Clinic may receive a flu shot.
