This is true because many tribal members are very interested in the subject of gaming expansion in general, and expansion to the Gorge in particular, said Madeline Queahpama-Spino, director of tribal Vital Statistics.

As of earlier this year, she said, about 60 absentee ballots had already been received at Vital Statistics. This was a

fairly large number, said

Queahpama-Spino, considering that the absentee voters had just received their ballots a short time earlier in the mail.

On the reservation, the level of interest in the Gorge casino proposal is also very high. For instance, hundreds of tribal members have participated over the past several weeks in the home-base family gatherings regarding gaming expansion.

These meetings proved to be a successful way of sharing ideas among tribal members regarding gaming expansion and related topics, said gaming spokesman Rudy Clements.

Other tribal officials have commented that as much as possible has been done to involve and inform the membership in the gaming expansion question.

Tribal Council Chairman Olney Patt Jr. made statements following each of the candidate endorsements.

Regarding Jack Roberts, Patt said, "He understands the need for economic self-determination for Oregon's tribes. He was well-versed on our issues and showed a remarkable knowledge about many issues of tribal concern, including treaty rights, need for educational improvements and basic natural resource management."

Patt added, "As Oregon's Labor Commissioner, Jack Roberts has shown talent in bringing together people of diverse cultural, political and economic viewpoints. I think

he would make a great governor. I urge Republicans to support him in this Primary election."

In regard to the Kulongoski endorsement, Patt said, "We are endorsing him because of his long and positive history with Oregon tribes, and his openness in approaching issues important to us, such as education, salmon recovery and protection of tribal sovereignty." Patt added, "When a person takes public office, they swear to uphold the Constitution and laws. With his experience as Attorney General and Supreme Court Justice, Ted knows what this commitment means for Indian governments and for our treaty relationship."
